
Message from the Senechal cont...



Congratulations to Lord Angus on becoming DFT's newest Senesachal. I hope you all will join me in wishing him much success.


Thank you Lord Franklin for your 2 years of devoted service. I know you will remain close ready to volunteer whenever DFT needs you.
