Notes From An Old Rapier Marshal

What are we really asking of you?

One of the most commonly required things to be asked of you at populace is to vote yes or no on some upcoming demo or event, but what are we really asking of you? If you are a newer member of the SCA you might think the only question here is something like, is this a good idea in general or would it make good press for our local group? Please be assured there is much more to be asked than just that. Not even our great Kingdom has unlimited money or people to do something and so each choice must be weight against all others for the best outcome.

This is even more true for smaller groups. I remember a populace from about 24 years ago when a shire voted to put a float in the local Christmas parade. We had the use of a flatbed trailer and building a castle out of one inch wood and chicken wire was a snap. Then came stuffing each and every hole in that chicken wire with tissue paper to make our float! 30 people voted this a good idea but 4 of us got stuck making it happen! For 30 sets of hands this could have been done in two hours. For 4 of us it took four Saturday's in a row to get it done and barely in time for the parade. Your Seneschal is not just asking if it sounds like a good idea, he or she want to know if you really support this thing being done! A good rule to use here is just ask yourself two questions. One, would I vote for this if I knew it could not be done without one full hour of my time and effort? Two, would I vote for it if I knew it could not happen without me personally giving one dollar of my own to help make it happen? If your answer to either of these questions is no then you do not really support this idea and should vote no. I am not saying you cannot vote for a demo that is going to happen when you are at work and so cannot attend, just not if you don't truly support it. After all, if you like the idea and would have gone if you could, you might send some of your things along with notes on when and how they were used in history, but how likely is that if you thought the whole idea was silly? Please remember you are voting on a demo or event idea, and not for how much you like the person who thought of it. This is most definitely-not a popularity contest! Ask all the important questions like when, where, how much will it cost, how many people will we need to do it, and so on. You should never vote for anything you do no fully understand. Your group is asking for your honest support for something and they need the truth here. Never give a single thought to which way your vote might make you seem like the more caring or nicer person. You real answer is all that matters here, not a pretty speech for something you are not going to be any help making happen no matter what. It could be a great idea for a group that really wants to do it and a bad one for your group because no one locally knows anything about it or cares enough to learn. Why do you think all SCA events are not just alike in all details anyway? It is true you do not have to have an A&S minister to hold the kingdom A&S event, and that the Kingdom will help you pull this off, but if only two people like the idea and all the rest vote no? Then you really risk being too short handed to make it work if you try to push the populace in a direction they just don't want to go. Every idea deserves consideration, but in the end there must be real support to make it work.
