A MESSAGE FROM OUR SENESCHAL


Unto the members of the Tor, Greetings,

Elfsea Baronial Artisan Champion This year's theme is "bring your best".

The Candidates will be asked to:

1. Display an art or science piece; documentation is recommended but not required.

2. Demonstrate their ability to teach an art or science by teaching one class.

There are things that will be looked at in the classes.

• Knowledge of the subject, ability to answer questions or direct toward finding resources.

- Organization and flow of information.
- Ability to adapt to the needs of the current class.
- Directions for finding resources.

Divide Between Pure Target Archery and Crossbows in the SCA

We have always had this divide between pure target Archery and crossbows in the SCA. Not because crossbows aren't just as period but more the way we view them. Yes, it is quicker and easier to learn to shoot a crossbow than a longbow, but if you think that means you can win all the time using a crossbow without the need to practice the answer is no. The fact that it is easier to teach and learn is one reason why crossbows were so popular in period for both war and hunting. I have never been able to see why they should not be allowed to compete with all other bows. If it was used in the same time period with and against all others why should we draw a line now? I have yet to find anyone who thinks English longbows should not have to face middle-eastern horse bows or any other type of bow for that matter. If you feel it's just too much the better weapon why on earth would you not choose to use it yourself? We are all noble born in the SCA after all and longbows were a peasant weapon. The nobility had some truly magnificent Crossbows which can still be found all over Europe today. The fact that crossbows are very cool just speaks for its self. I think the first point of contention maybe as simple as the fact that sights are allowed for crossbows but not for regular bows. This is because sights for a regular bow are a modern invention whereas rear sights for a crossbow are very period. Sadly our style of shooting makes them more needed because the only way a crossbowman could sight straight down the shaft at a target 40 yards away would be to run the draw weight up to over a hundred pounds to stop the drop off. Which of course would go straight through the backstops we use at 20 yards like they were not even there. Most SCA crossbow have a draw weight of between 50 and 75 pounds which will drop almost a foot at 40 vards. You can aim two feet over the bullseve with a regular bow and still see it right beside the lower limb of your bow but even aiming four inches above the bullseve with a crossbow and you will no longer be able to see any of the targets face at all. A rear sight just lets you keep the field-tip pointed right at the target and just lower the back of the crossbow until it makes up for the drop off to reach it. So why do a few folks feel it would be some kind of a cheat to be able to see the target you are shooting at? That's really all a rear sight lets you do. I have even had people tell me the renaissance sight is far more accurate than the simple sight. How anyone could possible think five holes in a straight line on a round piece of metal can somehow be more accurate than five holes in a straight line on a rectangular piece of metal is utterly beyond me. I feel silly just saying it! I personally put more limits on the crossbow I used than the SCA requires. You can buy SCA style crossbows from websites with the same butt stock found on a more modern flintlock rifles though I have never seen a period crossbow so made. The closes thing I have seen in period is a long Italian stock ending in scroll work that was held in the armpit of the shooter.

I personally use the much older and more common roller nut system rather than the clap lock or recess systems. The roller nut crossbow came to England with the Normans and stayed in use throughout the Renaissance all over Europe. A Spanish one from 1554 was found on Padre island right here in our Kingdom. The clap lock style did not come along until about 1530 and is very rare in period crossbows. If you were not a king or prince it is very doubtful you would have one. The recess (so called as a cut in the stock holds the string below the table) was a Swiss creation from about 1400. There no proof it ever found much favor anywhere outside of Scandinavia. Why I cannot guess has it is the simplest and easiest crossbow ever made. What's the difference? Clap locks and recess fire the second you fully pull the trigger while a roller nut must make a full quarter rotation before the string is freed and it shoots. If your point of aim wonders off during that time, oh well you miss the mark. It must also have the nut reset after almost every shot which really slows you down in a speed shoots while both the others styles of crossbows have no such weakness. About the only period thing I refuse to do is the carrying of my bolts field points up rather than down at my belt for the obvious safety reasons. To be fair period archers were no fonder of crossbowmen than they are today. So if you put them down because your persona would have I cannot fault you for that. If you think no good crossbowman come ever lose to a better bowman then you need to spend more time with some good bowman. I once had a member of the Arc d'Or who had shot both for many years tell me that while it's easier to get started with a crossbow over the long bow it still takes just has much time and hard work to be really and truly good with either one of them. I think you would be very hard put to find a time in the history of this great kingdom when all of its championships were held by crossbowmen alone. How could anything possible make the point any more clearly than that?
