Which follow:

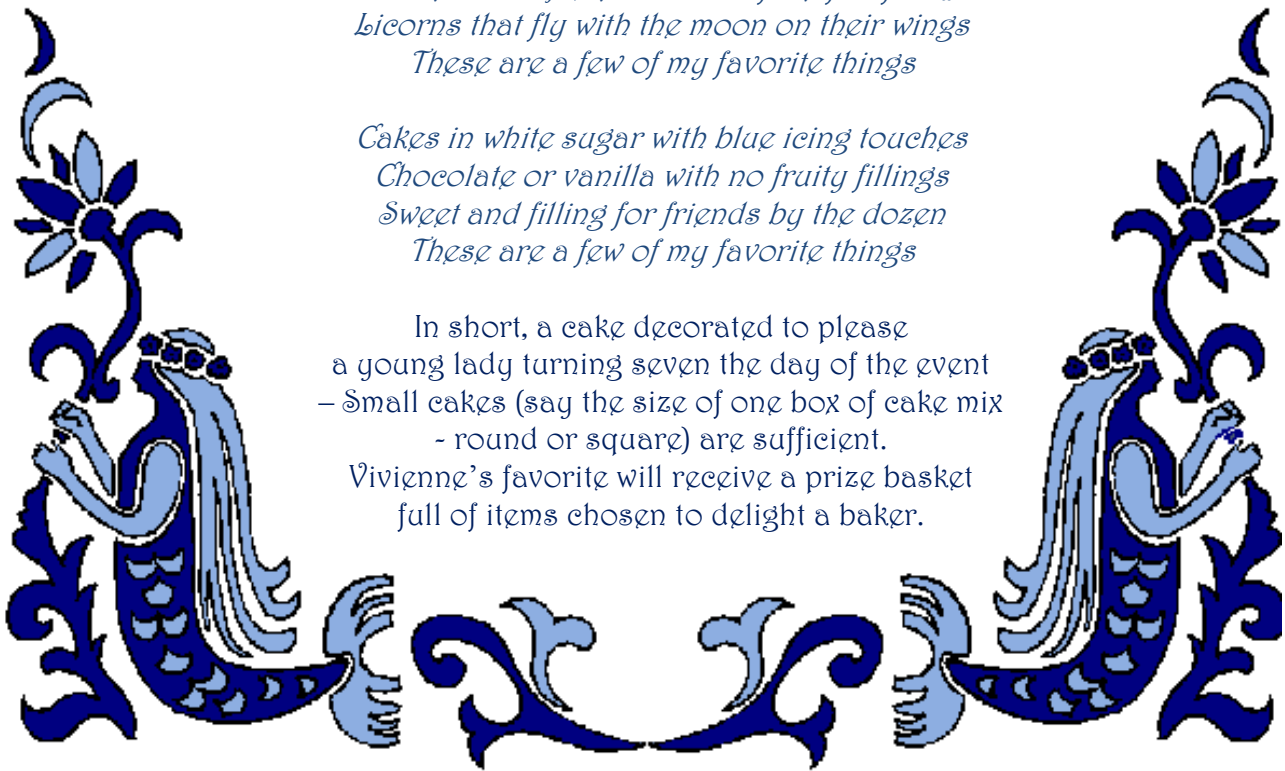
*Princesses dancing and scales on dragons

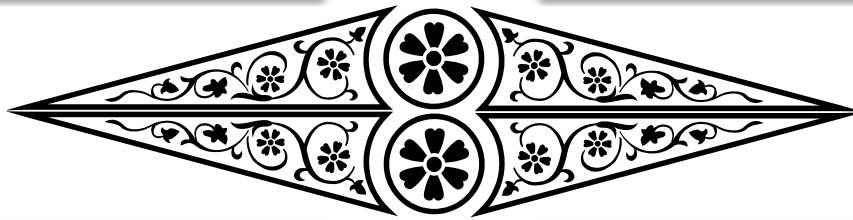
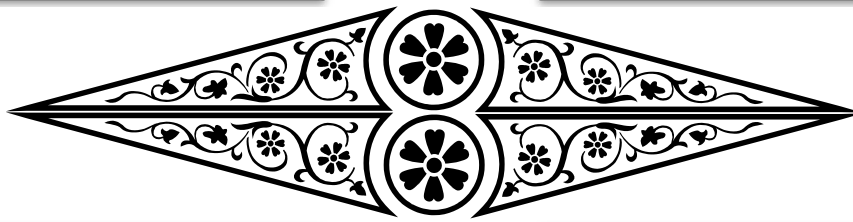
