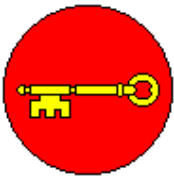

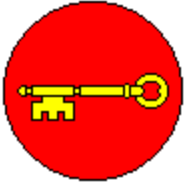

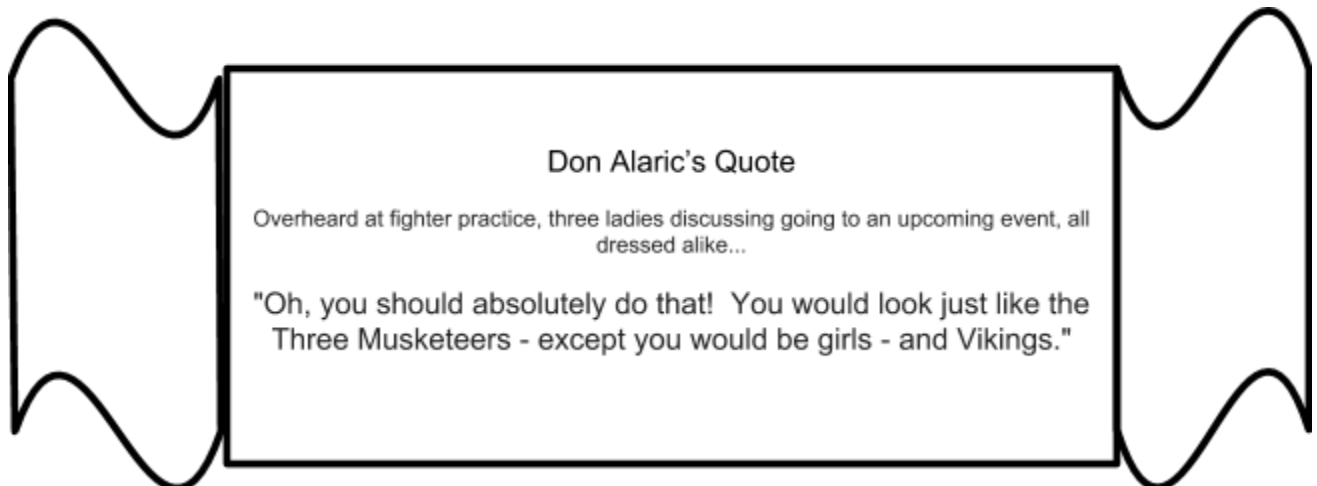

Greetings,

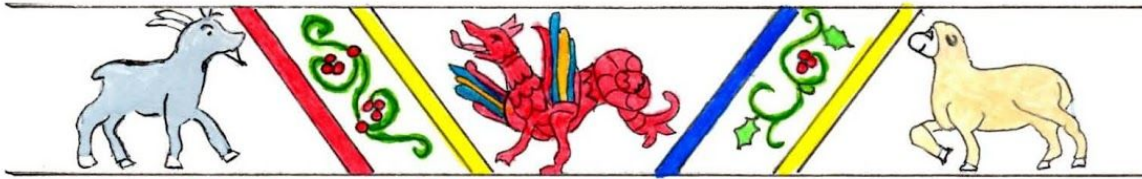
