There is updated information that brings us into compliance with U.S. copyright law and guards against misusing anyone's image or work. Most importantly:

- Any image used in a newsletter in which a person's face is recognizable must have a release from the photographer and subject.
- Do not include any person's mundane name or contact info in a publication unless you have a release from them for that information.
- Black Star event ads must include a release for the event stewards' personal information.

Elfsea Discord server, which has quickly become a lively place for conversation, coordination, and camaraderie. I am grateful that she continues to share her talents as my Discord Deputy.

For those I have not met yet, I am Lady Signý bjarki Sigurðadottír, your new Social Media Officer. My goals are simple: help more people discover Elfsea by encouraging participation on social media, and grow our Barony by sharing the joy and fellowship that make this group so special. I am seeking a TikTok Deputy to help create short videos about our events, people, and projects. This month, we launched our six-week **Step Into the Story** campaign to encourage participation and celebrate service across the Barony. It is already showing remarkable momentum.

Between September 22 and October 22, 2025, Elfsea's Facebook page achieved:

• Views: **9.2** K (656% increase)

• Reach: 1.9 K (641% increase)

• Content Interactions: 372 (553% increase)

Visits: 259 (121% increase)Follows: 3 (50% increase)

In simple terms, more people are seeing our posts, reacting to them, and getting involved in Elfsea's story. The more our content is shared, the more we grow, one post and one connection at a time.







Camping Like It's 1399: A Modern Guide to SCA Camping

Few experiences blend history and adventure quite like camping at an SCA event. You trade neon tents for canvas pavilions, polyester sleeping bags for woolen blankets, and the glow of your phone screen for the flickering of firelight. Whether you're a battle-hardened knight or a wide-eyed newcomer, a little preparation goes a long way toward making your time in camp as enchanting as the tournament field.

1. Choose Your Shelter Wisely

If you're going for period accuracy, a canvas pavilion, wedge tent, or bell tent is ideal, they're breathable, durable, and look the part. Just remember: they are heavier than modern tents and can soak up moisture like a sponge. Bring a sturdy

ground cloth or tarp and keep your gear off the ground in case of rain. For those less worried about authenticity, a modern tent hidden behind your camp setup keeps you comfy without spoiling the illusion.

2. Sleep Like a Lord (or at Least a Comfortable Peasant)

Sleeping on straw-stuffed ticks sounds romantic until you realize straw pokes. A modern air mattress or cot discreetly hidden under wool blankets is a sanity-saver. Wool is your best friend, it insulates even when damp and fits right in with the medieval vibe. Add a sheepskin or two for both comfort and flair.



3. Fire, Feast, and Fellowship

If open flames are allowed, bring a fire pit or raised brazier for cooking. Cast iron cookware handles the heat beautifully, and there's something satisfying about stirring a stew with a wooden spoon while others roast meat on spits nearby. Stock up on period-appropriate foods that keep well, bread, cheese, apples, dried meat and stash a few modern snacks for when the authenticity wears thin.



4. Garb and Gear

Bring at least two full sets of garb, you can never know when the weather could turn and you are in need of dry clothing. Pack extra socks and sturdy shoes or boots suitable for uneven ground. A cloak or hooded cape doubles as warmth and weather protection. For gear, think practical: a lantern, matches in a waterproof tin, a folding chair with a cover to blend in, and a water jug or leather flask.

5. Comfort Meets Chivalry

Events often run long into the night, with singing, and storytelling of that day's battles on the open field. A small folding table, a camp stool, and even a discreet battery pack for emergencies make life easier without shattering immersion. Don't forget sunscreen, bug spray, and a first aid kit, medieval medicine can stay in the 14th century where it belongs.

6. Mind the Mood

The real magic comes from the community. Help your neighbors set up tents, share a drink by the fire, and lean into the illusion. Whether you're an artisan, bard, or battle-ready fighter, you're part of a living tapestry of history brought to life.

In conclusion, camping at a medieval reenactment is equal parts logistics and legend, a balance between surviving the weekend and savoring the past. Pack smart, stay kind, and when the night falls and the firelight flickers across your tent walls, you might just forget what century it is.
