



ROYAL WEDDING PLANS ON HOLD! by HL Lete Bithespring, Guest Correspondent

London, September 11, 1348 (late breaking news in from Bordeaux)

The city of Bordeaux, much affected by the recent arrival of the Black Death, is awaiting word on the health of our English princess, Joan, 15, daughter of King Edward III, who is presently fighting the French. Her mother, Queen Philippia of Hainault, rarely leaves England, except to visit her native Low Countries, and is not expected to visit the wedding. Crown Prince Pedro, 14, her groom -to-be, is the heir to Castile.

Rumor has it that the prenuptial documents have already been signed to guarantee any sons born to the marriage will succeed to the throne of Castile, regardless of any possible offspring by any future marriages of Prince Pedro. The nuptials of Princess Joan and Crown Prince Pedro will unite the two countries of England and Spain. The French, reputedly, are most fearful, as is to be expected.

With her, the Princess is reputed to have several dresses of silk, the latest fabric. Her wedding gown is rumored to be made of 150 meters of gold interwoven Rakematiz, a thick, imported silk. Her elaborate ghitas, one dark brown and one green, are also of Rakematiz. In addition, she has five corsets of Digaston, the heaviest silk. These are woven in various designs in gold.

It is understandable that one of the English ships in the harbor is allotted for just her clothes, her private, portable chapel, and other accounterments accompanying her to the wedding, now so in jeopardy by her dangerous illness.

This last August, Bordeaux Mayor Raymond de Bisque greeted Princess Joan and her large entourage, including 100 English archers. Also present were England's former Chancellor and now Head Diplomat of the princess' entourage, Baron Robert Bouchier, Oxford diplomatic lawyer Andrew Ullford, and Gerald de Podio, a Bordeaux Cathedral priest.

In front of this august group, Mayor Raymond de Bisque cautioned Princess Joan about the dangers of pausing in Bordeaux in her route through Gascony to Crown Prince Pedro's home in Castile.

Not long after this meeting, the princess' executive, Baron Robert Bouchier, succumbed on August 20 there in Bordeaux. Many of her entourage have fallen ill and died.

Bodies of locals are reported as piling up in the streets and especially at the docks where the old Plantagenet castle, Chateau de Ombriere, is situated by the estuary. An expensive section of the town, the docks are the primary storage area for bales of cloth and wool.

With all these deaths, fear is mounting that Princess Joan may not survive. Fervent prayers are being offered for her recovery.



I'd heard some whispers on the wind that this movie was coming out, but for whatever reason, whether it just never played here in Lonestarrora at all or whether it did hit a few of the "arts" film houses for all of a week before going away, I never caught it in the theaters. So all I can say is, "Thank heavens for Netflix!" Because that's where I found it, and now can review it for you. I'd been looking forward to it because it's a Norwegian film based on an incident in the history of Norway, and I wanted to see how well they did it, in addition to wanting to know a little bit more of the background. I'd heard a little of the story a few years back, when attending a conference in Oslo, Norway I was able to listen to Marianne Reusch talk on "Skis as Charges in Scandinavian Coats of Arms" (and isn't that a pretty narrow topic!), and she noted that the incident about which this movie is centered was commemorated in the coat of arms of the municipality of Lillehammer.

So, yeah, I was interested in seeing this movie, and was very happy to have finally found it. And so it is that this month, Da'ud Bob reviews for you **The Last King.**

Starring Jakob Oftebro as Skjervald, Kristofer Hivju as Torstein, Inga Ibsdotter Lilleaas as Ylva, Ane Ulimoen Overli as Inga, Elg Elgesem as Frikk, Pål Sverre Hagen as Gisle, Thorbjorn Harr as Inge, Stig Henrik Hoff as Erlend, Thea Sofie Loch Næss as Kristin, Torkel Dommersnes Soldal as Egil, Benjamin Helstad as the King, and Jonathan Oskar Dahlgren as the infant Håkon Håkonson, the story takes place in the year 1206, when Norway was in the midst of a civil war, and one side, the Birkebeiners, set off on skis bringing the two-year-old (though he appears younger in the film) heir to the Norwegian throne to safety. (Just so you know how it comes out in the end, the young boy later became King Håkon IV Håkonson and ended the last civil war in Norway.) But it's mostly and action movie, so there's lots of riding horses through the snow, pulling sleds through the snow, and cross-country skiing, beaucoup kinds of fu, and a lot of suspense and close calls.

Good points: The ponies. Period skis, which are shaped very differently from modern skis, and use entirely different methods for strapping onto your feet. Period skiing techniques. Much of the armor. The hurdy-gurdy. The cross-country skiing. (The Norwegians love to ski. They even make special skis with wheels so they can practice their skiing through the summer.) The weapons. The Northern Lights. The arms of Norway hanging on the wall of the castle.

Bad points: Some of the armor was later than the early 13th Century, the setting for the movie. Kristin walking a long ways through a cold castle while barefoot.

Zero breasts. One gallon of blood. 42 dead bodies. Sword fu. Axe fu. Crossbow fu. Fire fu. Spear fu. Poison fu. Arrow fu. Horse rolls. Skiers roll. Gratuitous fog. (I would have said "gratuitous snow," but it is winter in Norway, after all!) Academy Award nominations to Jakob Oftebro as Skjervald and Kristofer Hivju as Torstein for some really epic cross-country skiing, including walking quickly! - up a hill with skis strapped to their feet, and to Kristofer Hivju as Torstein for "If I die, I'm going to kill you." A 52 on the Vomit Meter. 3½ stars. Da'ud Bob says, "Oh, yeah, before I forget it, the coat of arms of Lillehammer is a shield with a blue sky above and white snow below, appearing like it would on the side of a mountain, with a skiing Birkebeiner bearing a kite shield and spear and carrying the royal child. The incident happened 800 years ago, and it is still commemorated in the heraldry of the town. If you like movies based on real history, you're gonna want to see this one. Check it out!"



Financial Policy Barony of the Steppes 2017

1. General

- a. All provisions of the Financial Policies of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. and the Kingdom of Ansteorra shall be applicable to this Financial Policy of the Barony of the Steppes.
- b. Society and Kingdom Financial Policy shall take precedence except where this Financial Policy of the Barony of the Steppes specifies more stringent requirements than shown in the Society and Kingdom Financial Policies.

2. Financial Reporting

- a. Monthly/Quarterly reports will be submitted to the Central Regional Exchequer by the last day of the month following the report month (e.g. February monthly report is due by March 31) and copies sent to the Central Regional Exchequer.
- b. The Landed Nobility of the Steppes, Seneschal, and members of the Financial Committee shall receive a copy of the Exchequer's monthly report by email or hard copy within 30 days of filing. A copy of the report shall be available for any member of the populace to review upon request. Current balances of the barony's checking and savings accounts shall be published at least quarterly in the baronial newsletter.
- c. The Annual Report (Domesday report) shall be submitted to the Central Regional Exchequer and Kingdom Domesday Deputy by the date specified by the deputy with copies provided to the Seneschal and Landed Nobility of the Steppes.
- d. The baronial Financial Policy shall be reviewed by the officers at the October Business Meeting, submitted for approval by the populace at the November Business Meeting and submitted to the Central Regional Exchequer by November 30th of each year.

3. Financial Committee

- a. The Financial Committee shall consist of: 1) Landed Nobility of the Steppes (who have only one combined vote); 2) Seneschal; and 3) Exchequer. There will be two other local members at-large. These two positions shall be announced and opened for bids.
- b. Applications shall be considered and voted on by the populace at the Business Meeting.
- c. No two Financial Committee members shall share the same address or have a close familial relationship (with the exception being the Landed Nobility of the Steppes).
- d. At-large members elected shall serve a term not to exceed two years.
- e. The committee shall meet once per month and also for a specified purpose or emergency action if requested by a member. Items to be reviewed can be sent out and discussed by e-mail in advance of a meeting.
- f. Financial Committee members that miss more than two scheduled committee meetings shall be reviewed in absentia at any official meeting of the officers to determine if removal from the Financial Committee is warranted. Lack of communication can be grounds for dismissal.
- g. Vacancies shall be announced at the monthly Business Meeting and published in the newsletter. Vacancies shall be filled within 30 days of the position being vacated.
- h. Financial Committee members shall be paid members of the SCA.
- i. All members of the Financial Committee shall either have attended a treasurer's financial policy class within the past year, or attend a treasurer's policy class at the next available opportunity such as Round Table or King's College.

4. Budget

a. Each officer shall list anticipated expenses for that office for the coming year and submit them to the Exchequer for review by the Financial Committee prior to September Business meeting. If no budget is presented, the Financial Committee shall assign a budget to that office.

- b. The Barony's yearly budget shall be presented to the populace at the October Business meeting and submitted to the Central Region Exchequer by November 30th.
- c. An acting officer can request access to spend the budgeted funds for said office, after review by Financial Committee.

5. Expenditures

- a. Non-budgeted expenses shall be reviewed and discussed at the Business Meeting. They shall then be reviewed and approved by the Financial Committee prior to the funds being spent.
- b. Receipts for pre-approved out-of-pocket, non-event expenses shall be submitted within two populace meetings (approximately 60 days) from the date of purchase or the expenses may not be reimbursed. Exceptions may be made with Financial Committee approval.
- c. All expenditures (budgeted and unbudgeted) require the advance completion of either the Check Advance or Check Request form. Budgeted expenditures require approval of the Exchequer and unbudgeted expenditures require approval of a simple majority of the Financial Committee.
- d. Fully documented receipts shall be provided to support all expenses. This rule applies to anyone expecting reimbursements.
- e. Any single capital expenditure exceeding the value of \$500 shall be proposed and advertised in at least one issue of the Barony of the Steppes Newsletter prior to the business meeting at which the expenditure will be decided upon. The full populace present at the business meeting shall have opportunity to make comments prior to the decision. The decision shall be made by the Financial Committee.
- f. With the unanimous approval of the Financial Committee, any single capital expenditure exceeding the value of \$500 may be made without advertisement in the Newsletter if a decision must be made prior to such a time as would allow typical procedure for high-dollar capital expenditures.

6. Cash Receipts

- a. Gate receipts shall be deposited into the baronial account within five business days of the end of the event.
- b. All other receipts shall be deposited no later than 14 calendar days after receipt.

7. Event Bid Process and Gate Policies

- a. All bids shall contain the following information, and shall adhere to Baronial, Kingdom and Society laws.
 - i. Basic budget for the event to include, but not limited to site rental costs, porta-johns, prizes, printing, site tokens, feast/food, and miscellaneous expenses.
 - ii. Autocrat's résumé, SCA or mundane. A brief note about history or qualifications shall suffice.
 - iii. Contract or quote from the site.
 - iv. Basic idea of theme, contests, etc. for event. These are in addition to any Baronial Championships being decided.
 - v. Family Max charge for the event.
 - vi. Individuals who will receive complimentary admission to the event.
 - 1. Landed Nobility of the Steppes
 - 2. Current Crown plus one entourage
 - 3. Current Consort plus one entourage
 - 4. Current Heirs plus one entourage each
 - 5. Current Steppes Warlord plus their Consort of Love and Beauty
 - 6. Current Steppes Rapier Champion plus their Consort of Grace and Honor

- 7. Current Steppes Archer
- 8. Current Steppes Bard
- 9. Current Steppes Artisan
- 10. One event Steward
- 11. One feast Steward
- b. The Financial Committee shall determine the financial viability of all event bids with attached budgets.
- c. All viable bids shall be presented to populace at Business Meeting for discussion. Bids are to be presented by the person submitting the bid.
- d. The Financial Committee shall vote to approve the bid.
- e. A list of people to receive complimentary admission shall be provided to gate that lists both SCA and legal names. Anyone not on the comp list shall be approved by the Financial Committee no later than two weeks prior to the event.
- f. Requests for reimbursements for event purchases shall be approved by the event autocrat and turned in to the Exchequer within 5 days after the event in order for the event report to be prepared and submitted within 10 days as required by Society Financial Policy.
- g. Joint events shall be subject to all group financial policies, with baronial representation. Event bids for joint events must include a breakdown of agreed upon group contributions, responsibilities, and profit/loss split. All Financial Committees involved shall approve and sign the bid.

8. Assets

- a. The baronial physical assets shall be stored in an approved storage facility under the supervision of the Quartermaster, the Exchequer, and the Seneschal. An inventory of all baronial property shall be conducted not less than once a year and a copy of the inventory listing shall be signed by the Financial Committee and forwarded to the Central Regional Exchequer by November 30th of each year.
- b. A copy of the inventory shall be provided to anyone who requests a copy.

9. Designated Funds

- a. When a Designated Fund is set up, a primary purpose shall be established by the donor or by the Financial Committee. The final destination of all Designated Funds is the Baronial General Fund.
- b. Designated Funds may be transferred to the General Fund only if there has been no activity for a reasonable period of time and the transfer has the unanimous approval of the Financial Committee

10. Miscellaneous

a. The Barony shall loan funds or property to SCA, Inc., and its subsidiaries only. Prior to lending or borrowing funds or baronial property (including wall hangings), the Barony shall have, in writing, an agreement with the borrower detailing the method of return, repayment, liability, and profit disbursement.

10. Guilds

- a. Formation of a guild shall comply with Kingdom of Ansteorra policies regarding such.
- b. For guild operations, the appropriate officer's budget shall be utilized for guild purchases, with the approval of said officer. If the amount requested exceeds \$50, it shall be decided upon separately by the Financial Committee.
- c. Inventory of guild holdings shall be done as necessary, not to exceed an interval of 2 years.

11. Trailer

- a. All trailers owned by the Barony of the Steppes are to be used for storing and transporting baronial property to and from SCA functions. Trailers owned by the barony shall not be used for strictly personal purposes by members of the barony.
- b. Anyone towing a trailer owned by the Barony of the Steppes shall be a member in good standing, and tows the trailer at their own risk.
- c. Agreements to store and tow the trailer shall be made in writing in advance between the member storing or towing the trailer for each trip and the barony. Each agreement shall include specifications of timeframes and calculation for any expense reimbursement. Each trip shall be considered round-trip, and the member towing the trailer is responsible for its return at the end of the trip, unless otherwise specified in the agreement.
- d. Trailers shall always be loaded in compliance with the trailer's maximum gross trailer weight rating, maximum tongue weight rating, and load balancing instructions. Trailers shall be attached to a towing vehicle rated for that type of trailer. Trailers shall be attached using all legally required attachments and restraints and working electrical connections.
- e. If there is available capacity in the trailer after the baronial property is loaded, and there is a desire to transport additional personal property in the trailer, it is allowable that additional personal property owned by baronial members is placed in the trailer. Any personal property is loaded into the trailer at the property owner's risk.
