

### Da'ud Bob Movie Review

### Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon: The Sword of Destiny



I'll admit it – I had my doubts about this one. I mean, it was billed as a sequel to the original movie which came out in 2000, and that was a great movie to see, but sequels, well, frequently just never come up to the quality, story, and acting of the original. So it had that going against it from the start. Then, it was done by Netflix, a company that hasn't always had the best reputation for the films they make. (They are getting better, but it's still sometimes a bit of a crapshoot as to whether you'll get something really worth seeing or something that you'll forget by the next day.) And only one of the actors in the original signed on to reprise their earlier role, so there was that. But I just knew that, despite all of my misgivings, I'd have to review this one for you. So I prepared myself as best I could, sat myself down

in front of the big-screen HDTV, called up the Netflix queue, and pressed the Play button on the remote. And so it is that this month, Da'ud Bob reviews for you the 2016 Netflix Original Film Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon: Sword of Destiny.

Starring Michelle Yeoh reprising her role from the original as Yu Shu Lien, Donnie Yen as Meng Sizhao / Silent Wolf, Harry Shum, Jr. as Wei Fang, Natashs Liu Bordizzo as Snow Vase, Jason Scott Lee as Hades Dai, Eugenia Yuan as the Blind Enchantress, Rogen Uyan as Iron Crow, Juju Chan as Silver Dart Shi, Chris Pang as Flying Blade, Woon Young Park as Thunder Fist, Darryl Quon as Turtle Ma, Veronica Ngo as Mantis, and Andrew Stehlin as Black Tiger, this sequel to 2000's Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon could be viewed as CT, HD: The Next Generation or Twenty (well, okay, eighteen) Years Later or something similar. It does, however, relate to the original better when you understand that CT, HD was based on Book 4 of the Crane - Iron Pentalogy, a set of five books written by Chinese author Wang Dulu, one of the "Four Great Writers of the Northern School." Sword of Destiny is based on the fifth book, Iron Knight, Silver Vase. In this movie, Yu Shu Lien, still mourning the death of Li Mu Bai at the end of Crouching Tiger, returns to safeguard his sword, the Green Destiny. Hades Dai, an underground warlord, sends his lieutenants to steal the sword, with which he plans to dominate the Martial World (because it will make him invincible, don't you know). A mysterious young swordswoman and the hero with a past, Silent Wolf, comes to Shu Lien's aid, together with a disparate band of warriors who still believe in the Iron Way of honor.

Good points: The paper lanterns. The very quiet "ninja" fight between two people trying to steal the sword without waking up anyone in the place or causing an alarm. The cinematography. The floating paper lanterns. Much of the fight choreography.

Bad points: Lots o' physics- and gravity-defying wire work. The wire work is not as smooth, or graceful, as in the original movie. Some of the coincidences which help to drive the plot seem just a little bit too contrived to be convincing.

Zero breasts. Two gallons of blood. 62 dead bodies. Spear fu. Sword fu. Nunchaku fu. King fu. Ax fu. Knife fu. Dart fu. Dagger fu. Ladle fu. Ice fu. Bird claw on a stick fu. Three-pronged pitchfork fu. Mace fu. Cart rolls. Fighters roll. Gratuitous snake amulet. Gratuitous plate twirling. Gratuitous big honking sword. Academy Award nomination to Darryl Quon as Turtle Ma for being one of the most instantly likeable characters in the movie, "famous … in this tavern" (while everyone else in the little band of warriors helping Lone Wolf, a group immediately reminiscent of The Seven Samurai, was famous in this province or renowned in that city). A 62 on the Vomit Meter.  $3^{1/2}$  stars. Da'ud Bob says, "It's reminiscent of a Shakespearean tragedy; almost everyone dies by the end of the film. But it's quite a ride to get there. Check it out!"


