The parade will be staged in the east parking lot of Norman High School. You will need to enter the high school area at Kansas & Pickard, northeast of the football stadium. There will be parade volunteers to help guide you to your destination upon arrival. Please have your parade line-up number ready for these volunteers.

Please note that this parking lot area is for staging of the parade only. There will not be any parking available for vehicles that are not in the parade. There are many parking lot areas around the high school available for these vehicles.

Line-up begins at 9:00 AM. The parade will start promptly at 10 AM. Please place your line-up number on your float or vehicle.

This is a moving parade. Please do not stop to perform when you reach the announcers. You will need to perform while continuing to move.

Please remember- NO Santa entries. The committee has asked Santa to be there and we do not want to confuse children. Please note that Santa will be at Kidoodles Toy Zone, 425 W. Main St. after the parade for pictures!!

Do not throw candy. This is a city ordinance and you may be fined if caught. Please hand out candy to the crowd so that small children do not run out into the road.

Entries with children will be required to have an adequate number of adults to ensure safety. 1 adult for every 5 children please.

Winners of the parade will be announced in Sunday's Norman Transcript and awards can be picked up from Copelin's Office Center.

If you are in need of a great breakfast, please attend the Kiwanis Pancake Breakfast inside the high school. The event is from 7am-1 pm. Tickets are \$6 for adults and \$2 for children 12 and younger.
