General Business

- Financial Discussion with our Exchequer (Treasurer), Honorable Lady Adena. As always, if you would like to see a copy of the financial policy, the budget or the books, please contact Adena.
 - Financial Policy
 - Revisions:
 - Non-related signatory must be on the checks.
 - Dedicated funds: categories added, with timeframes to reevaluate or revert to general fund.
 - Society Policy Change: One has to be a paid member to be fully comp'ed. If not a paid member, they will still need to pay the \$5 non-member.
 - Modified the family max wording.
 - Trailer Hauling: Defined reimbursement level at 14 cents per mile. Must be pre-approved by financial committee and included in the event bid.
 - Added propane procedures. Propane must be include in event bid.
 - Budget
 - Adena discussed the current budget. If you have questions or would like to see a copy, please request it from her.
 - Financial Report
 - Adena reviewed the procedure for doing the financial reports and how they aren't as hard as you would think. Please ask her if you are interested in becoming a deputy.
- Website Discussion with our Webminister, Lord Yancy Alfsson
 - Kingdom website option/update.
 - Kingdom builds the shell using WordPress
 - New web address
 - Kingdom still hosts website, no fees or cost to Barony
 - Would require that all future Webministers be tech savvy and know somewhat what they are doing.
 - Found a deputy!
 - Yancy will be making website updates.
 - What do you feel is missing from our website and what should be included?
 - What is not needed?
- Round Table Discussion
 - Waivers
 - Please turn in a waiver sheet for every practice. If everyone has a blue card, turn in the waiver form with "all blue cards" written on it.
 - Regional practices or similar events need to be treated like a regular practice. The hosting or local group needs to have an officer present,

along with a marshal on the Kingdom's warrant for all activities included in the practice. Waiver also need to be completed and turned in.

- Warranted Deputies
 - Make sure you deputies are warrantable and you have let you northern regional officer (or kingdom if you don't report to a northern regional) know you have appointed a deputy. The easiest way to do this is to have them fill out the application for office (with the office applying for being the _____ deputy). Get some type of reply email or sign off from the northern regional and forward the application and response to the seneschal for record purposes.
- o Reports
 - Be sure to copy the seneschal and the Baron and Baroness on your reports.
 - It is also important that they be turned in on time as they are used by others for their reports.
- Harrasment Policy
 - Harrasment is a repeat or patterned behavior.
 - Use the "what would a reasonable person do" test. Would a reasonable person feel this is acceptable behavior?
- Doxxing
 - DOXXING (i.e. posting personal information/contact information/political information about individuals) is a violation of the SCA Code of Conduct and the Anti-Bullying and Harassment policy. DOXXING is also against the law in California and a number of other jurisdictions; furthermore, DOXXING may likewise be actionable as an Invasion of Privacy which may result in a civil suit and money damages. Please convey to all of your officers at both the Kingdom and local group level that any officer or agent of the SCA found to be DOXXING is subject to termination from their office.
- Retention and Recruitment
 - 2018 has been deemed the year of Retention and Recruitment by the Kingdom!
 - They are encouraging larger demos or free events for recruitment purposes.
 - Luckily, we already do Med Fair which reaches a lot of people.
 - The seneschal and hospitaler are looking at some options for a newcomer event so be on the lookout for more information on that as it develops.
 - Also be thinking about other recruitment activities or ideas and feel free to share them with the Baron and Baroness, hospitaler, or seneschal.
 - To help with retention:
 - Remember at events or meetings to not be overly critical of garb, etc. especially if it isn't someone you know well.
