 - Must have basic event info on the Kingdom Calendar 90 days in advance (website, Facebook , dates, location).

 - Capital Expenses – We are in a financial standing to purchase some items the barony might be needing. Proposals were discussed at the July Financial Committee meeting.
 - Archery Nets: Approved Option 3 for \$300 (10' x 20' (x2))
 - Display Cases: Provisionally approved \$200, pending design approval and committee involvement.
 - Feast Serving*: Approved \$490 (bid minus forks and mini forks).
 - Firestorm Ink: Approve total \$218.47, will discuss splitting with Wiesenfeuer
 - Free Event: No at this time, can re-evaluate for individual events in the future or discounting for youth/children.
 - Mosquito Zappers: Will re-evaluate at the end of summer.
 - Zero-Turn Mower: Not approved.
 - Tablecloths*: Approved \$175 for fitted table cloths.
 - TW Stands: \$175 approved (from TW budget)
 - Water bearing: Approved \$30 for water bearing dishes
 - Pavilion Walls: Committee approved \$1540.68 to purchase, but this is over \$500 so will undergo populace approval at tonight's meeting.
