A few more weeks until Beltane! Here are a few updates:

The theme for this year's event is Calendimaggio, which is an Italian event that celebrates the rivalry between the blue and the red parts of the city with friendly competitions. Everyone will be assigned a side at gate and then can compete in any of the 15 or so competitions throughout the day. If you or your team win one of the competitions, not only will you win a small prize but your team (red or blue) will earn points. The side that collects the most points throughout the day will be declared the winner at evening court! Points will be awarded for all of the championships, caber toss, quizzes, a cookie competition and more. There will be competitions for men, women, teams, and kids!
