

From the Northern Resional Seneschal

Greetings to the People of Namron!

Your current Baron and Baroness, Kyna and Andrew have announced their intention to step down during the Kingdom's 40th Year Celebration. After consulting with them, your Seneschal, the Kingdom Seneschal, and of course Their Majesties, the following schedule has been agreed upon.

•**Thursday, June 06**: The deadline to declare baronial candidate status—no new entrants are allowed after this date. Final letters of intent by baronial candidates are due to the Crown and Heirs by email.

•Monday, June 10: The final opinion poll form with candidate names is posted to the baronial website. Brief, single-page candidate letters with full contact information are also posted to the website.

•Saturday, June 22: All baronial candidates meet one-on-one with the Crown and Heirs at King's College, to be hosted by the Barony of Bonwicke.

•**Thursday, July 4**: The July edition of the baronial newsletter, The Plume is published. It includes the final opinion poll form with the names and candidate letters of the baronial candidates, the same as found on the baronial website.

•Thursday, July 11: July Populace Meeting.

•**Thursday, July 25:** This is a good date to send an email to the Crown with your commentary about the baronial candidates.

•**Thursday, August 1**: The Big Day. Polling occurs during the regular populace meeting, 7:30pm at Norman Unitarian Universalist Fellowship, 1309 West Boyd Norman, OK 73069. The Kingdom or Regional Seneschal will be there to conduct the polling.

•Thursday, August 08: All absentee opinion polls are due by email to the Kingdom Seneschal. This is the final date to send an email to the Crown with your commentary about the baronial candidates.

•Saturday, August 24 (One month before 40th): The Crown and Heirs announce their final decision.

•Friday or Saturday, September 20, 21 (40th Year): Their Majesties officially invest the new Landed Nobility.

Now for the fine print: This schedule is subject to change at the will of the Crown. Each candidate is responsible for ensuring that they meet the application deadlines and requirements. All the general populace is tasked with keeping themselves informed of the process and providing constructive input to Their Majesties.


Newcomer Anxiety

Some of you may have jumped right in and never looked back. However, some (including me) may have been lost not knowing how to get involved in all the things.

Now let's talk about that jerk known as ANXIETY. Yep, I have it and I would like to share my story with you.

I remember my first attempt to join the SCA. I was lost and unfortunately because I am single, I didn't have someone to be new with me. The first event I went to was Beltane 2016. I was by myself and although people smiled at me and said hello, I felt utterly alone. I wanted to join in but honestly didn't know anything and certainly didn't understand most of what people were referring to. I became shy, reserved, and EMBARRASSED! For two years I would see events and pictures posted on the Barony's Facebook page and again wish I could just get involved. It took me a full **two years** to get up enough nerve to come back. I knew I would need to find something I am good at. I realized I am good at helping and serving others. So I volunteered at the hospitality tent at the Medieval Fair for all three days. I was so exhausted after those three days but I met so many people through volunteering. I thought "That's it! I found my thing in the SCA!" Whenever I saw something posted where I could help, I volunteered. Three months later I became the Barony of Namron's Hospitaler.



Society Vocabulary Explained!

~Officers ~

Autocrat / Event Steward – the person in charge of an event. Sometimes you will see the suffix "-crat" added to other words to identify the person running the activity (e.g. Feastocrat, Merchantocrat). However, many people prefer to try to use real words from the Middle Ages.

Minister of Children (MOC) -officer in charge of children's activities.

Hospitaler – an officer who helps new members learn about the SCA.


Chronicler – the editor of the group's newsletter.

Exchequer – the officer serving as treasurer for a group or kingdom.

Herald – officer who helps participants come up with SCA names and armory; or, the official who makes announcements on the field, or is the Master of Ceremonies for court. Local group heralds are called *Pursuivants*.

Marshal – a specially trained person who oversees combat activities for safety purposes. A *Knight Marshal* holds this office in a local group. The *Earl Marshal* holds this office in a principality or kingdom.

Seneschal – the officer serving as "president" of a local group or kingdom. Acts as the group administrator and legal representative of the SCA.


On his return to our fair barony, storms wracked our lands and canceled practice!!

Spanish Pan Fry Chicken

3 lbs chicken breast	1 clove garlic
3 Tbsp vinegar	1 tsp saffron
1½ Tbsp Soja Sauce	some olive oil to brown the chicken
1/2 tbsp ground coriander	salt and pepper to taste
1/2 tsp ground cumin	

Directions: (cooking time for the chicken = 1h)


- 1. Cut chicken into medium cubes (bite size pieces)
- 2. Brown chicken pieces in a medium skillet.
- 3. Put aside to rest.
- 4. Add vinegar, soja sauce, oil, garlic, and spices to the pan. When the sauce begins to boil, add the chicken back. Cook covered over low heat until the chicken is done.

With this recipe, you can use a whole chicken by doubling the recipe and carving the chicken into pieces. Heat a clean pot, add vinegar, soja sauce, oil, garlic, and spices. When the sauce begins to boil, add the chicken and cook covered over low heat until the chicken is done.

(Chicken must be cooked to 165°F internally for food safety)

There are stories from, 'No shit, there I was' to inspiring tales of those we have lost. There are memorial pages. There are group pages for each group which need content, help and information! People can contribute in so many ways, even with just a sentence or two. If they can type email, they can edit content on the wiki. If they want an account, I can set it up for them, just email me."

There are no requirements, titles or memberships needed to have an Ansteorran History Wiki page. The only rule, so far, is the persona lives or lived in Ansteorra. Zubeydah has several forms available, from general information needed to fill out a Wiki page to official SCA model release forms.

Wiki pages are alive, growing creatures that need to be fed information to serve many purposes; these can be things such as general history of a persona, events attended, instructions on how to shine bright, or a place to show talents and craftsmanship.

All personas in Ansteorra are important enough for their own page, because it will grow with them.

The wiki pages may be added to, changed, and updated at any time via the online form, email, messages on social media. A moose bit my sister once.

His Excellency, Master Robert Fitzmorgan, OP, built the Ansteorran Wiki during his tenure as Kingdom Historian in February of 2009. Zubeydah said His Excellency "put together the initial Wiki framework and built the first pages. He basically uploaded all the code framework and put together the guidelines for content, and built a lot of the early content our first Crowns, etc." Zubeydah took over the reins on October 13, 2011 as the official wiki administrator. With the Kingdom's growing enthusiasm, she has been able to almost double the total number of pages from 412 to currently 805. And she's nowhere near done.

Zubeydah dislikes blank spots and needs the populace help to fill them. She said, "It has the potential to be a huge resource for class handouts and knowledge sharing. We aren't there yet, but it's growing, bit by bit. And knowing that potential, but not reaching it and being unable to gather it, is hard. This isn't a task for one person, it's a task for dozens. But we just don't have that many active users."



Currently, she is planning on attending Ansteorra 40th year event, which will have a huge history project.

She will do a live demo on a computer with internet access to show everyone how easy it is to add information to the Wiki pages. Those in attendance will be able to witness how she documents our Kingdom's history and possibly add information for documentation. She has expressed a willingness to go to groups inside of Oklahoma to do wiki classes and work sessions. She is able to bring a camera, the proper release forms, and a scanner for documents or handouts. Zubeydah will also be at available at Summer Crown Tournament if anyone wants to talk to her in person.



Reflection on Sceppes Warlord

What a Fust event! We arrived on site Friday evening, got set up, and then went to visit many of our friends that were already there. We got to spend time telling stories, singing songs, and enjoying a refreshing drink Υ
