From the Seneschal

Hola Barony-

This month I have been thinking about the word Seneschal and its roots in history.

Seneschal first appeared in the late 14th century to describe the person who was in charge of a household. A household was not necessarily a home but could depict any such space like a home, village, or any area under the control of a royal.

The word seneschal comes from Old French and is the title given to a high administrative court officer. From my own personas perspective, this person was called the *mayordomo* which is essentially the superintendent of a household or the "mayor of the palace".

In SCA practice, the seneschal is the "local club president" when working with the outside world. They are the person that is responsible for reviewing and signing contracts and rental agreements.

They are also often responsible for ensuring the group is following mundane law and SCA policy. Often the seneschal will mediate disagreements within the group and do their best to protect the health and best interests of the group.

Finally, the seneschal does a great deal of paperwork and making sure that all the necessary paperwork is being sent in from the other local offices.

Although my time as seneschal has been short, only six months in as of this writing, I have learned a great deal from the experience. The position drives you to learn more about policies and procedures of the SCA. I have also learned more about the necessity to use phrases like, "I don't know that answer, but I'll find out and get back to

you." It has been a good experience and I look forward to what I will learn in the future.

For example if you were to have KGA after your name, it means you have won the award of King's Gauntlet of Ansteorra, which in simple terms is an Award of Arms given by the King to a person for great service. Another abbreviation is QGA for Queen's Glove of Ansteorra, which is the same award but given by the Queen. I hope this answers your question, and please feel free to ask more questions.

Society Vocabulary Explained!



People in the SCA

SCADian (SKAY-*dee*-*an*) – as a noun: a member of the Society for Creative Anachronism. Also:

SCAer. Used as an adjective to mean "of the SCA."

Gentle – any person, not gender-specific.

Populace – the inhabitants of a kingdom or local group; the people present at an event.

Chivalry – fighters recognized by the King and Queen for their great skill on the tourney field. Companions of the Chivalry are the *Knights*, who swear fealty to the Crown, and *Masters-of-Arms*, who do not.

Laurel – Someone recognized by the King and Queen for mastery of an art or science.

Pelican – someone recognized by the King and Queen for great service to their Kingdom and the SCA.

Squire - a student in a formal relationship with a Knight or Master of Arms.

Apprentice – a student in a formal relationship with a Master or Mistress of the Laurel.

Protégé – a student in a formal relationship with a Master or Mistress of the Pelican.

Peers – companions of the Chivalry, Laurel, and Pelican.

Royal Peers – Viscounts, Viscountesses, Counts, Countesses, Dukes, and Duchesses. A Viscount/ess has served as Prince/ess of a Principality. A Count/ess has served as King/Queen of a kingdom once, and a Duke/Duchess has served more than once.

Minister – the gender-neutral version of Mistress/Master for office names.

Mistress/Master – title used by companions of the Orders of the Laurel and Pelican, and Masters-of-Arms. Also part of some office names, i.e., "Mistress of the Lists", "Master of Arts & Sciences".

Dame - an alternate title used by female members of the Orders of Chivalry, the Laurel or the Pelican. who do not wish to use the title "Mistress" or "Sir".

Loro/Lady - a title for someone who has been given their Award of Arms by the King and Queen.

There are a variety of Title Language Equivalents that can be used for those who wish to use a specific language for their persona. For more information please click <u>HERE</u>.

Hosipitaler's Pen and Quill

When I first became Namron's Hospitaler, I wanted to start the Aimcrier program for all the Newcomers to our Barony. What is an Aimcrier? I am sure our archers in the Barony know! For the rest of us, let me give you the definition.

AIMCARIER: an applauder, encourager; the person who cries "Aim!" to the archer.

I wanted people in our Barony to volunteer to be an "Aimcrier" and be assigned a "Newcomer". The Aimcrier would be the newcomer's applauder, encourager and to help them find their aim and purpose in the SCA. In general their mentor. Several people signed up to be an Aimcrier (Thank you!!!) but I soon found out that in all honesty, *all of us* should be Aimcriers!

Let's take a look at the meaning I intended for Aimcriers. I imagined a newcomer being assigned a Mentor-Aimcrier that would be with them every step of the way in their new adventures . Guide them and encourage them in all things that interest them. The Aimcrier would help the newcomer with their first event and their first camping experience with the SCA. Introduce them to people and help them learn all the important things a newcomer should know.

But I quickly realized that friendships and bonds in the SCA are organic and fluid. There was no way my Aimcrier project would be completely successful as I originally intended. I realized in reality we the People of the Kingdom of Ansteorra and of the Barony of Namron are all Aimcriers. We should all encourage Newcomers and one another. So I humbly ask all of you:

Greetings Barony,

The Bank of Namron has \$12,749.96 with \$765.30 dedicated to the Ada group, Oak Spring. Please note that I can only write checks at Populace and Business meetings. I apologize for the inconvenience but checks must be signed by two members of the financial committee. If you have a heraldry submission, please make sure that the Herald, Lord Captain Savage, is also in attendance so that all paperwork can be done correctly! Thank you.

I attended the July Roundtable and have information to share! First, I am excited to say that Dalla Hróđmarsdottir has stepped up as the Canton of Skorragarðr's exchequer! Congratulations! I look forward to seeing all the work she's going to do for the canton.

The kingdom exchequer gave the Barony of Namron a check for \$566.64 from our Gulf Wars volunteer work. Skorragarðr received a check for \$179.01! We had a very successful volunteer year! We've been asked to support the kingdom MoC next year at Gulf Wars at the Page School. Ansteorra is in charge of it all week and will need assistance. Background checks are not required. Even 30 minutes of your time would be appreciated!

Other announcements that affect financial procedures: (Some of which we already implement)

- All groups must have a financial committee of at least 3 members even if they do not have a bank account. This will be made up of the Seneschal, Treasurer, for Baronies the B&B, and then members of the populace. Each member has to take the treasurers class.
- All Group Exchequers must have an Emergency Deputy. I am working on acquiring a deputy. Ideally, I will be able to announce who it is in next month's newsletter! If you are interested in helping or learning but do not want to be ER deputy, I will be glad to show you how the office is run! No commitment required.
- All reporting exchequers are required to publish the income and balance pages once a year to the public. We are getting prepared to publish it for the next Plume newsletter from both the Barony and Canton's reports.

Gate Policies:

- If an adult shows up at Gate with a child that is not theirs, they should have the minor waiver and the notarized medical release form. Make sure that Gate sees the notarized medical release but does not keep it. The adult responsible for the child must keep this form.
- The person working the money box must be a paid member. The people working the books or the PayPal form do not have to be paid members.

There were some potential policy changes made but they are not finalized yet. When I am officially told the changes I will announce it to the barony. So please be prepared to hear from me on the subjects in the upcoming months.

In August, there is expected to be an announcement that submissions will not be automatically returned if they only need redrawn The submitter will be contacted and able to approve or submit a correction (it hasn't been fully decided which yet). This will change the delay from six months to **three**.

Oscar 2.0 has been outsourced to try and get it ready to be launched.

There is now a group that is taking on the 'Precedence Tagging Project." They will be tagging and indexing the precedence list.

Make sure when you're filling out submission forms that you're including as much information as possible to help with the approval process. This includes if language/culture is important to you, if the meaning of the name is important (make sure you list the meaning), if the way a name sounds is



important to print a phonetic spelling that you want, and *make sure to include your contact email*. Communication is key to the college of heralds working efficiently.

There will be no submissions accepted in kingdom at Pennsic.
