# · One set of "fancy" court level Coronets.

o Must meet Ansteorra Sumptuary Laws.

o Able to fit a majority of head sizes.

o Made of practical, easily repairable materials and coatings.

### · One set of "field" Coronets.

o Must meet Ansteorra Sumptuary Laws.

o Must be relatively lightweight and comfortable.

o Able to fit a majority of head sizes.

o Should be durable.

# · Two tabards displaying the Principality Arms for the Prince and Princess.

o Must meet the heraldic standards for signifying the Coronet and differentiating the Prince and Princess.

o Must be a one size fits most pattern.

o Must be made of durable materials to withstand use on the field of battle.

o Must be machine washable.

# · One Heraldic Tabard displaying the Principality Arms

o Must be a one size fits most pattern.

o Must be able to absorb tears.

### · One banner displaying the Principality Arms.

o Must be colorfast.

o Must be able to easily mount to a variety of walls or pavilions.

# · One Pennant

o Must be able to withstand the winds of Gulfnado.

o Must be colorfast.

o Must be able to flap in a moderate breeze.

# · Any other overlooked item that you feel is essential to the Proposed Principality.

o Must provide a very good reason why the item is needed.

o Must not make any future Chamberlain wish that this item never existed.

# From the Minister of Children

# Fall Greetings!

It's my favorite time of year! I love the colors, smells, cooler weather and all things. Not to mention Protectorate! We are going to have some fun activities. You may see a few "faces" from our Barony. I'm pretty excited.

Did you know, before the 16th century, <u>harvest</u> was the term usually used to refer to the season Autumn? The alternative word fall for the season traces its origins to old Germanic languages. The exact derivation is unclear, with the Old English fiæll or feallan and the Old Norse fall all being possible candidates.

### Leaf Lantern



Autumn Leaves in different colors and sizes (smaller is better), grease proof paper – any will do, but if you can find white, even better, cheese boxes (to give the lantern structure, but of course, you can make your own base etc from cardstock), glue or stapler,

if turning into a St Martin's lantern – wire and a stick, electric tea lights

- 1) Press leaves between sheets of newspaper for a couple of days. This has two effects the newspaper absorbs the damness and also flattens the leaf a bit, which gives you a nice finish. Note: if you leave the leaves damp and wet in the paper longer than 2–3 days they MAY start going moldy. All we aimed for, was for the paper to absorb the dampness and also to flatten the leaves a little. Not to fully dry and preserve them!
- 2) Cut two sheets of grease proof paper to fit around your cheese base and at a height that you want. Lay one sheet flat on the floor and add glue.
- 3) Add your leaves let the kids do as they wish, more is more I am sure! But I also find you will get a better glow if they don't overlap too much.



4) Add more glue and then press the second sheet of grease proof paper on top. You can place some books on this for an hour or so to give a nice smooth flat finish, or you can skip right through if you don't want to wait.



5) Take your cheese boxes. You can remove the "top part" of the lid, so you have access for the candle. Staple or glue boxes. Then repeat for the bottom (admittedly the bottom is a bit fiddlier as harder to get there.. but it worked ok). Note: If you do not have a cheese carton, you can use cardstock, cut to the same size to make the base and top of your lantern. Glue or staple. If using cheese boxes, lantern will not hang.

6) Add wires or string so you can hang you lantern off a stick.
