



We will be outside for the time being, and we will look into moving to an indoor location during the winter months. We will reschedule if possible for rainy days.


I am so excited for the chance to get back to practice before my time as your Marshal is up! Thank you all for your patience for just a little while longer.

From the Minister of Children

Springtime Greetings Namron!

This is one of my favorite times of the year. All the blooming. I especially love seeing the leaves grow on trees. Spring just seems to bring a bunch of joy, hope, maybe a few sneezes, and just a spring in your step. With that, I have hope that soon we will be able to get together. I'm already planning ahead for Protectorate in the fall, which will be my first, in person, event since stepping up as MoC for Namron. I'm excited. I'm hoping to get a few extra helpers and deputies so that by the time Protectorate comes along, we will have everything planned out and ready to go. Kids like to run and chase the birds when they see them in the yard and sometimes try in



parking lots. Did you know that was an important job back in the medieval times for kids to do? Kids helped throughout the year when it came to farming. Once the seeds were sown, it was important to keep the birds from eating too many of the seeds. So kids would use drums, bells, sticks, yell, clap their hands, and even chase the birds to keep them from eating the seeds. It was very important and a good job for the kids to have.

The kids also helped with weeding. Once the seedlings started to sprout, it was important to keep the weeds down to allow the seedlings to be able to grow strong and big. Without enough sun and space, the seedlings wouldn't grow very big.

Another job that children were able to help with was collecting and gathering. Depending on their age, children would go gather twigs and branches throughout the year before winter hit so they had firewood for the winter months. Children helped gather eggs just like many kids do today. During the late summer and autumn months, they would help collect berries and fruit from the fruit trees.

For this month's home activity, I hope you will give your shot at gardening. Start saving eggshells and egg cartons to put them in while you grow your seedlings. When you crack them, carefully crack them where they have at least half of the shell to use as your pot. Wash those eggshell seed pots out with warm, soapy water. Use an ice pick or heavy sewing



needle to punch a drainage hole in the bottom and let your kids have at them with non-toxic markers. You can draw silly faces, name your plants, or maybe draw a picture of what you think your seedling will look like.

Most garden vegetables are good for starter plants in eggshells. Herbs are another good seed to plant. You can plant some basil, dill, or parsley. Maybe you would rather skip the vegetables and herbs and just plant some flowers. Well that works too.

Once you are ready to start, add some potting soil and usually, just sprinkle the seeds on top and gently pat them down. Once you do that, keeping the soil moist and keeping it in a sunny area is key. Try a spray bottle to avoid drowning your seeds. Once your seedlings have at least 2 good sets of leaves, it's time to plant them in the ground or a larger pot, eggshell and all. Once the shell is in place, gently crack the shells to allow the roots to grow through. A great thing about using eggshells is that it adds calcium and other nutrients to the soil. So you are truly caring for your seed from the start!

This spring, I hope you do try to plant using an eggshell, help garden, pull weeds, gather, scare the birds away from those strawberries they enjoy to feast on and just have fun. Have a happy spring and I hope to see you all soon!
