





### This month's activity, Medieval Art!

Giotto was an Italian painter in the 1300s. He is known for adding depth to pictures by adding the background and for making his people look more life-like by adding emotions. Giotto mainly painted frescos. A fresco is a painting done on wet plaster; the color really sinks in and gives the color a glowing look to it.

Giotto's artwork includes...

### Making Homemade Egg Based Paint!

Giotto used an egg based tempera paint. So we are going to make our own egg based paint for our artwork.

First, crush up some chalk using a rock, or anything handy. You can use a rolling pin for ease, put the chalk in a zip lock bag to keep things clean.

Mix up 2 egg yokes with 2 TAB water. Then add it to the chalk. Your paint is ready to go. (You can use muffin tins to keep the paint separate.)



Unlike other artists of his day, Giotto used bright colors in his paintings. He was also the first major artist to convey emotions in his painting.



Notice the yellow halo around people's heads. Giotto painted scenes from the Bible and like others from his time used halos to depict saints.
