NEWS FROM BARON YANCY AND HERSIRKONA KOLFINNA

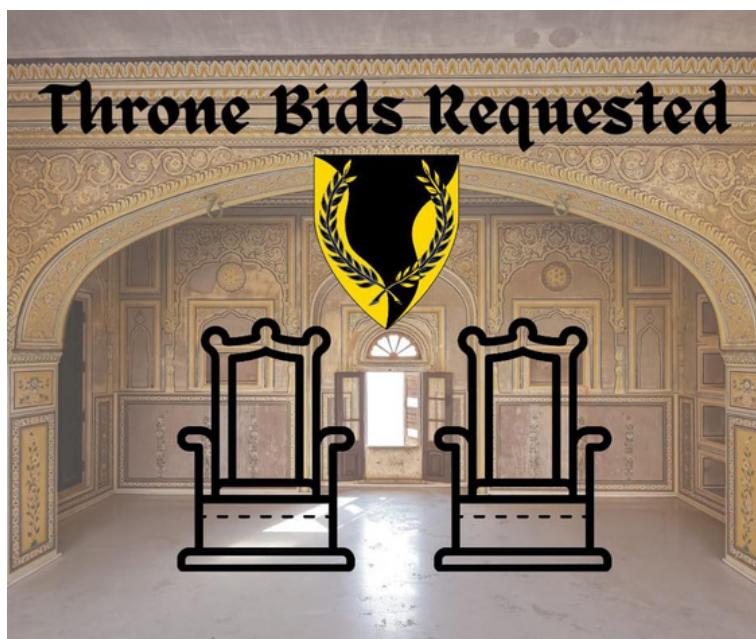
Greetings, Good Gentles of the Storm!

Our personal knockdown chairs will be used until suitable replacements can be procured. We would like to thank our Baronial Quartermaster, Seren of Namron, for coordinating the workday for repairs on Phred the Shed (and for bringing snacks!), and thank you to everyone who came out to help. Most of the construction and roofing was finished, but we have postponed painting until we have a little warmer weather.

Since we were already at one of the sheds, the bulk of loading for Beltane was completed, too. Having so many people there to help with that was a great boon. Thank you! And a special shout-out to The Destructors, two of our young newcomers, who helped tear stuff up and throw it away!

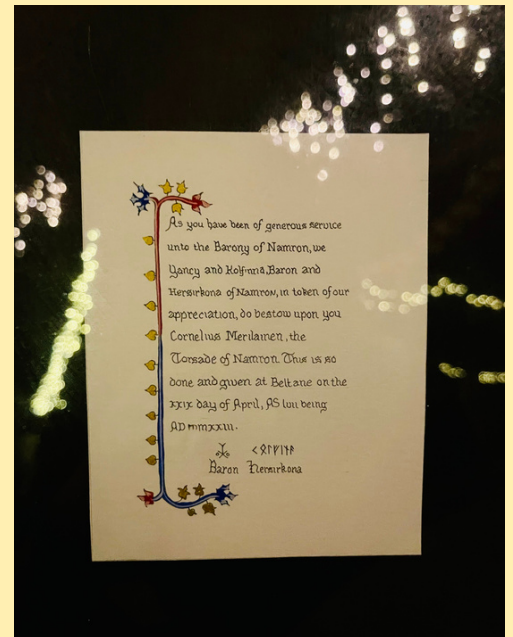

FROM THE TARGET ARCHERY MARSHAL

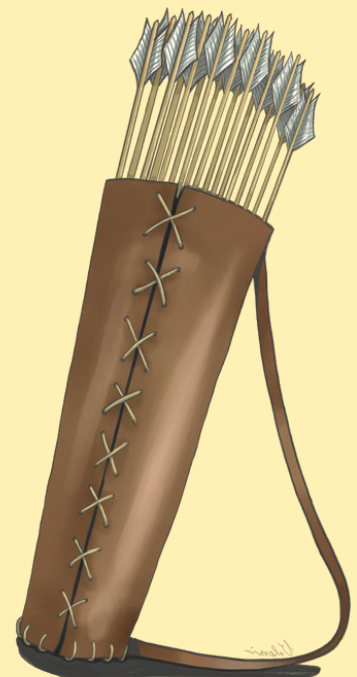
Greetings Namron from the Archery Marshal,

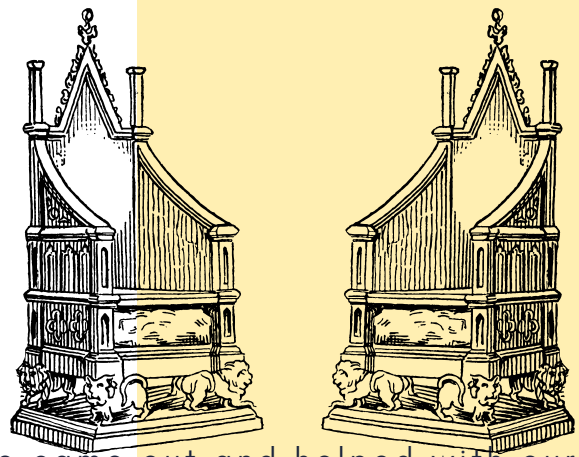
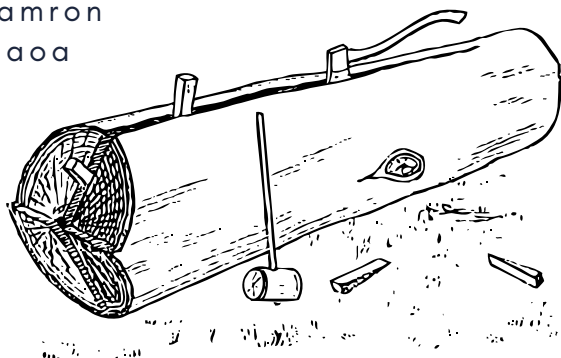

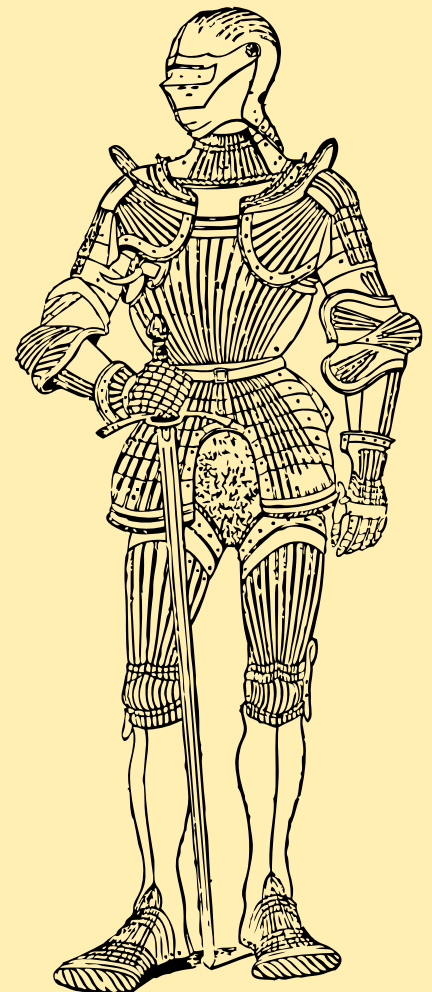
