Greetings, Good Gentles of the Storm!



FROM THE THROWN WEAPONS MARSHAL

Hello and Salutations from the office of The Throwing Weapons Marshall.

First order of business, we had practices!!!!!!! Woohooo!! I Will get some dates set up for for the future and am going to attempt to work around Events. Please keep and eye out on either your email or on the Facebook page.

Last month we went over The Gaulish Throwing Stick. This month we will Toiluch on the Hand Quarrel.



Hand Quarrel

Just adding feathers to a knife to make it fly straight, this is a "straight forward" idea, you may easily have. Indeed, such thing was cultivated by the Irish warriors during the Roman times. Throwing technique is still needed, anyway.

FROM THE THROWN WEAPONS MARSHALL

This device stabilizes to a straight trajectory by the effect of the feathers in the rear – means by air friction and weight distribution. The front is additional made heavy. It is thrown similar to a dart, only with more power. Compare this to the "Spanish Dart", which also has a straight trajectory, but achieves this not by feathers, but by rotation around it's length axis

HAND QUARREL

As early as the first centuries AD, the "hand quarrel" - probably best translated as "hand arrow" - was found as a typical armament of the Irish auxiliary

troops of the Roman army, hence the name "Irish quarrel". You have to think of this javelin as Imagine an oversized arrow with a length of around 175 cm and the corresponding weight, in a smaller version often made of metal: in the hand of an experienced thrower, a deadly weapon!

The modern hand arrow, on the other hand, is more like an oversized dart (throwing dart or spiker), is only 28 cm long and consists of a knife blade (10 cm) with a wooden handle (8 cm), onto which the shaft of an arrow that was broken during archery is attached If this graft is removed, you immediately have a perfectly suitable utility knife. The device is given additional weight by a winding of lead solder.

The hand arrow is thrown like a dart and always hits with the tip first. With a little practice, you can quickly achieve a certain level of accuracy without having to worry about the distance to the target or the number of revolutions - as is usually the case when throwing knives. Isn't this a throwing knife for amateurs...?


