

Work list

1. Fences

- Tear Down Fence-lines, remove and dispose of the barb-wire, pull posts with tractor, scoop some dirt in bucket and have someone fill holes with a shovel, drive over holes with tractor. Then Brush-hog old fence-line.
 - “incomplete” fence to the north of the “parking area”
 - “list-field” fencing to the left of barn (facing the back of property)
 - “list-field” fence furthest from the barn at the back
 - **DEADLINE OCT 31st**
- Repair
 - “Entrance gate”, the post that the gate latches to needs to be replaced. I have a 4x4 post in barn to replace it with. Unhook horse-fence, remove post, remove gate latch hardware, replace post and compact in place. Reattach hardware. Pound bends out of top of gate.
 - **DEADLINE DEC 31st**
- Install Top-Rail
 - We have 500ft of thick wire that would make a nice “top-rail” for the remaining fencing. This wire is also in the way in the tavern area. Needs to be stretched across the top of the posts (make sure posts are all level, cut off long posts) then stapled or nailed in place.
 - **DEADLINE OCT 31st**
- Weed-eat and clean up the remaining interior fence lines, particularly the parking area entrance fence
 - **DEADLINE DEC 31st**

2. Parking Area

- Walk the parking area and pickup sticks, debris, anything that doesn't belong
- Remove remnants of burn pile, move dirt to shooting berm.
- **DEADLINE OCT 31st**

3. Campsites (forest)

- Pickup anything over 1” diameter from the brush-hogged area.
- Pull any fallen trees and cut into no more than 6ft long pieces so we can haul out with tractor.
- Identify for approval your fire ring. It MUST be surrounded by brick, stone, or concrete.
- Any permanent campsite must be maintained throughout the year.
 - Keep fallen branches, etc. picked up.
 - Keep fire ring from being over-grown.
- Remove lowest branches from trees to make mowing easier.
- **DEADLINE DEC 31st**

4. Open Fields

- Pickup anything over 1” in diameter from fields and most importantly around all the trees so we can mow without any issues. Pile in tavern fire pit.

- Fill in holes, depressions, etc. Going to take a scoop of dirt from the tractor and smoothed out with rakes.
 - **DEADLINE DEC 31st**
5. Tree Trimming
- Large Walnut at front of parking area. Needs limbs below 8ft to be pruned.
 - Pecan with the broken branch to the left of the list field, prune broken branch.
 - Two large trees on the right side of the list field, lowest branches need to be removed so tractor can mow around them (8ft clearance)
 - **DEADLINE OCT 31st**
6. Barn
- Scoop and pile the remaining horse manure from the inside of the barn. Level floor of barn.
 - Move wood pile from the right side of barn to the rear left.
 - Repair the roof. Install Tin
 - **DEADLINE OCT 31st**
