Since the end of the pandemic, we have held the meetings at the Goree Recreation Center, the Thoreau Woods Unitarian Universalist Church, McKenzie's BBQ, and Olive Garden. 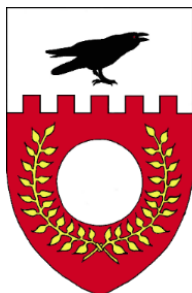
