




4 cups of passion for the Dream.

2 cups of SCA history knowledge. This can be a dry ingredient so make sure you have enough of the Dream on hand.

For spice, (because the best Hospitalers are spicy ones!) add in a variety of knowledge about some of the hobbies we recreate. The portions for this vary, depending on what hobbies you include. Just sprinkle until you hear the spirits of your ancestors saying, "Enough, child."

Mix all ingredients together and boil for a roiling good time. Once the passion and enthusiasm are well mixed, pour into a friendly mold and let firm. Once set, give them access to the Chatelaine information on the SCA website and turn them loose! Most well-made Hospitalers are self-driven and need very little direction. But, make sure that you are caring for your creation by feeding it occasionally with encouragement and praise. And above all, make sure you are supporting them in their demos and when they bring in Newcomers by sharing your knowledge and enthusiasm.
