Know that we, Mistress Deirdre ni'Raghailligh and Mistress Valia of the Mist do send greetings to Their Stellar Majesties, Creppin L'Ostriche and Toryn Seven Stiches, Their Royal Highnesses, Gabriel of Maccuswell and Sonja Ryzaja, to the Kingdom Seneschal, Brian o'hUillaim, Their Excellencies Ciaran Mac Giolla Bhrighde and Branislava Kirilova 'doch Volkova and to the populaces of the Barony of Wiesenfeuer and the Incipient Cantons of Myrgenfeld and Haldtre. After speaking with friends and family we ask that this missive serve as our humble request to be considered as candidates for the next Landed Nobles for the Great Barony of Wiesenfeuer. Valia and Deirdre started in the Barony of Namron over 27 years ago and have for the past decade live and played in the Barony of Wiesenfeuer. Deirdre and Valia and have been very active in both groups and both hold the non-armigerous baronial service awards (Torsade of Namron and Flint and Steel Wiesenfeuer) and are both members of the armigerous baronial service orders for Wiesenfeuer and Namron (Order of the Lanternarius and the Order of the Heart of the Sable Storm). Valia holds the non-armigerous arts and sciences award for Namron (Argent Fleur) and both hold the equivalent award for Wiesenfeuer (Flamme d'Orleans). Valia has Sable Thistles for Equestrian, for Middle Eastern Drumming and for Lampwork Beads, and holds a Sable Crane. Deirdre holds Sable Thistles for Leatherworking, for Cooking & Subtleties, for Period Games and for Lampwork Beads. Both are Companions of the Order of the Iris of Merit and both belong to the Order of the Laurel.

Both Valia and Deirdre have served as event and feast stewards for multiple baronial and Kingdom events. They have held these roles individually and collectively. Both have extensive service as entourage/ladies-in-waiting for both current and previous Landed Nobility of Wiesenfeuer. Deirdre served the Barony of Namron as Seneschal and currently holds that office within the Barony of Wiesenfeuer. Deirdre has also held deputy Minister of Arts and Sciences for both Wiesenfeuer and Northern Region.

Valia helped found the equestrian activities in Ansteorra almost 24 years ago, hosted the first sanctioned equestrian demonstration for Their Majesties William and Catherine, helped develop the first Equestrian Charter signed by Their Majesties Sutan and Regina, compiled the first Kingdom Equestrian Handbook and was appointed the Kingdom's first Minister of the Horse (now Equestrian Marshall). She holds the equestrian award of the Golden Bridle of Ansteorra.

Deirdre was active in the Rapier community in her youth and was Cadet to Dona Jerrod. Deirdre helped found the Blacke Orchid, a group comprised of scallywags, privateers, buccaneers, tavern wenches and cooks and other ne're-do-wells, rapier fighters and artisans who traveled the Kingdom inspiring other groups to form 'Ships' of their own. She served as the first Captain of the Blacke Orchid and again a few years later. The Orchid received a Letter of Mark from the Crown for their efforts in the Rapier community.

Both are active members of House Wolfstar, both have received numerous service recognition awards. For the past three years, Valia has served as Alpha (Head) of House Wolfstar, the first female to hold that position in the household's 30 year history. Valia is a respected and well know

leader of many drum circles throughout the Kingdom and has coordinated drum circles and haflas for numerous Gulf Wars.

Mundanely, Lesia (Valia) and Kim (Deirdre) work for the Oklahoma State Department of Education. Lesia has been an Administrative Assistant in the Special Education department for two and half years, overseeing office tasks and coordinating the state-related travel for 15-20 state employees. Kim started in the Comptroller's office as an Administrative Assistant for two years, then was promoted to Travel Claim Processor for the last three years. Kim is currently in her second year as the Employee Council President. She has been on the Council for the last three years. Lesia is currently on the Council and has been a member for the past year.

We both work four-day work weeks and have extended weekends suitable for frequent travel, with adequate vacation leave and income to conduct extensive travel and meet other financial obligations associated with baronial service. Kim and Lesia are parents of four adult children and ten grandchildren.

Our decision to be considered as candidates was not made lightly, we have, for the past decade, worked within the Barony of Wiesenfeuer as either entourage or ladies in waiting for no other reason than that's what we like to do and that's how we contribute to the Barony, our service and our arts. Chivalric Practice February 24th and March 2nd

SCA heavy weapons fighting is based on the medieval ideal of the knight. All SCA combat is real and unchoreographed. The weapons are made of rattan. Loaner gear is available. a donation of \$2 per person per session is required.

Scribal Meeting February 23rd and March 1st

Date: Tuesdays Time: 7pm Place: Sellers Rec Center³

Calligraphy and Illumination painting. A donation of \$2 per person per session is required. Loaner paints and brushes available.

Rapier Practice February 23rd and March 1st

Date: Tuesdays Time: 7pm Place: Sellers Rec Center³

Practices are sometimes cancelled due to weather or overlapping activities. Light weapons combat is an SCA form of combat used toward the end of the Middle Ages. Loaner gear is available. A donation of \$2 per person per session is encouraged.

Youth Combat February 24th and March 2nd

Date: Wednesdays Time: 7pm - 8pm Place: Sellers Rec Center³

Youth combat is for boys and girls age 6 to 15 years. They fight with foam-padded weapons. There are 3 age divisions within the program; 6-9 years, 10-12 years, and 13-15 years. The armor requirements and the strength of blows allowed increase as a child progresses through the levels.

Beginning Equipment for Youth Combat:

Each new youth fighter should wear long pants, a long-sleeve shirt, closed-toe shoes, lightweight gloves, and groin protection. A parent or an adult designated by the parent needs to be present throughout the practice.

There is some loaner armor but anything you can provide yourself is helpful. Armor requirements vary by age but all ages will need a helmet with face guard (such as a hockey or lacrosse helmet) and a gorget (medium-weight leather with ½ inch closed-cell padding). Knee and elbow pads are required for the older kids and helpful for the younger. The full armor and weapon requirements and rules for combat may be found in the Complete Participants Handbook. This is available on the Kingdom Earl Marshal's website at <http://marshal.ansteorra.org/armored>. Of course feel free to contact your friendly local marshal with any questions!
