Greetings Wiesenfeuer,

The SCA has announced that the moratorium on in-person events will not extend beyond the end of May. Several events are scheduled. Look to the Kingdom calendar to identify them. Remember that all events are currently limited to 150 people and require pre-registration and pre-payment.
