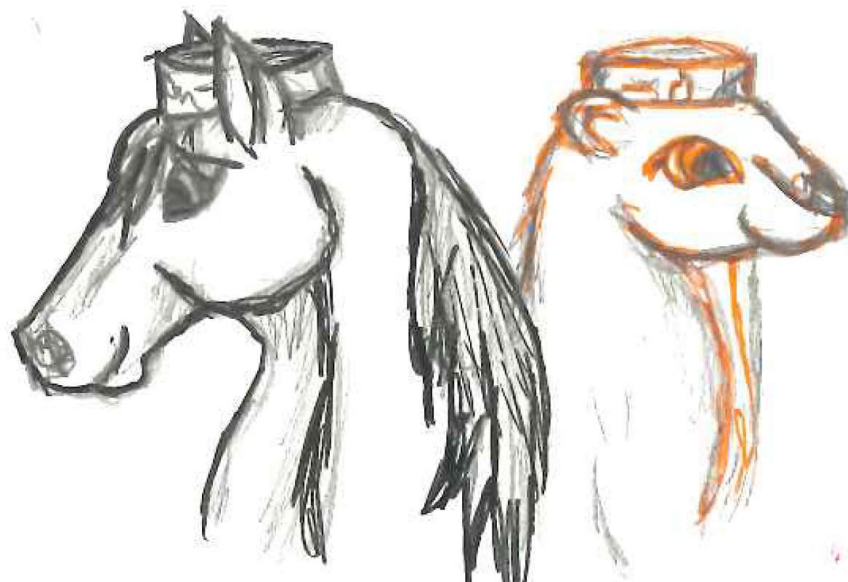

Thrown weapons practice is from 2 PM to 4 PM on Sundays at 5102 Woodhollow Rd.
