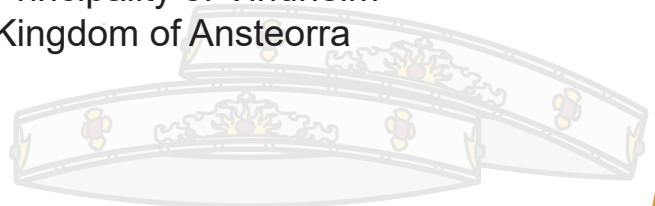

June was a busy month for Wiesenfeuer, and July isn't slowing down at all, either.

We started things off by at the Myrgenfeld Children's Collegium, where Muireen and Beatrix handed out a final few scrolls to people they had not been able to catch previously.

Later in the month, HL Ivo and Lady Guinevere worked together to herald two back to back courts during Coronet Tournament, with Ivo heralding the final Court for Their Excellencies Muireen and Beatrix, and Lady Guinevere handling the procession and the opening court for Their Excellencies Isaac and Eadwyn.

With the newly invested nobles of the barony, Lady Guinevere and Lord Klauss will be taking a larger role in the court and populace heraldry going forward, while Ivo continues his work as an officer and member of the baronial court.

King's College is coming up, and will include several heraldic classes, as well as a wide assortment of classes and demonstrations across a wide range of disciplines and SCA jobs.

And finally, that takes us to the The 2023 Local Herald's Professional Development Retreat. This is a Wiesenfeuer hosted training event unlike anything else offered by the kingdom.

To be simple about it, this is a plane-clothes event, lunch provided, where you can walk in the door at 9:00am, and by 5:30pm that evening, you will walk out the door as a competitive applicant for local herald. We are going to cover all aspects of being a local herald, from paperwork, to research, to ceremony, and a lot, lot more. July 29th, at Quail Springs UMC, in OKC. Show up and gate in between 8 and 9 am, and stay through closing court.

My Nalbinding Journey

by Her Excellency, Baroness Eadwyn seo Gathyrde

So some people might be wondering what is nalbinding? It can look a bit like crochet or knit in the finished product, but it's not. It does use a needle and yarn, like crochet and knitting, but whereas crochet and knit use a looping technique, nalbinding is a knotting technique that is a lot like sewing.

Facts about nalbinding:

Can also be called nålbinding, needlebinding, nalebinding, knotless netting or single needle knitting.

This technique developed independently in different parts of the world.

Nalbinding is very old and was already in use during the bronze age 1200 - 3300 BCE.

Nålbinding fabric doesn't unravel, even when a hole is worn into it.

Uses a single needle and thread. (even though you don't need a needle)

Creates flexible fabrics, often to make caps, footwear, gloves, etc.

When I first started to teach myself how to nalbind, I made a lot of mistakes and had to start over time and time again. I decided I need a goal, so I made a pair of mittens to enter in Wiesenfeuer Yule 2019. They ended up being mismatched but I entered them anyway. I was encouraged to continue practicing and improving my skill. With more practice I did finally get the hang of it. Earlier this year I entered an A&S composition with some fingerless mittens I made. The stitching on these mittens were much more even and the mittens matched each other. This was done with the same yarn as my earlier mittens but practice had made a world of difference.

Gluten-Free Orange Cake Balls

Ingredients:

For Cake

250g unsalted butter, softened
1 large navel orange, zested and juiced
225g sugar
4 eggs at room temperature, beaten to mix
250g almond flour
60g polenta
2 teaspoons baking powder

Orange syrup for soaking

3 tablespoons sugar
Rest of juice from the orange

Buttercream Frosting

1 stick salted butter, softened
2-2 ½ cups powdered sugar
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 Tablespoon heavy cream or milk

Cake balls coating

Use one or all of the following
White chocolate
Milk chocolate
Dark chocolate
Sprinkles (optional)

Directions:

Heat your oven to 350 F. Put the soft butter and orange zest into a mixing bowl. Beat well until creamy. Gradually beat in the sugar, a couple tablespoons at a time, then continue beating for 2-3 minutes until the mixture is light and fluffy. Scrape down the sides of the bowl before gradually adding the eggs, a tablespoon at a time, beating well after each addition.

Put the almond flour, polenta and baking powder into a separate bowl and whisk until all the clumps are gone. Pour the flour mixture into the mixing bowl, add 1 tablespoon of the orange juice (save the remaining juice for the

orange syrup). Gently fold in with a large metal spoon or plastic spatula. Spoon the mixture into an 8 or 9 inch cake pan, round or square. Bake in the heated oven for about 50 minutes until the sponge is golden and springs back when gently pressed in the middle.

While the sponge is baking, make the orange soaking syrup. Put 5 tablespoons of the saved orange juice and the sugar into a small saucepan. Heat gently until the sugar has completely dissolved, then simmer for a couple of minutes to make a light syrup. Keep warm.

As soon as the cake is out of the oven, prick the cake all over with a fork, then spoon the warm syrup over the hot cake. Leave until completely cool.

In a mixing bowl whip butter. Add in 1 cup of powdered sugar. Mix until combined. Add the vanilla and additional powder sugar, a little at a time. Add 1 Tablespoon of heavy cream or milk to make the frosting thick and creamy. It should hold a point.

In a large bowl, crumble the orange cake into fine crumbs. Add 2 spoonfuls of buttercream frosting to the cake. Combine with your hands or a spoon. Gradually add more frosting until the cake holds together if squeezed. This is a pretty moist cake so you probably will not add all the frosting. You also don't want it too crumbly or it won't hold together.

Using a cookie scoop, scoop out 1 scoop of cake mixture. Roll into a ball and place onto a plate or baking sheet. Repeat until all the cake mixture has been formed into balls. Freeze balls for about 10 minutes.

Right before you are ready to take the cake balls out of the freezer, melt the chocolate of choice. Begin by heating for 30 seconds in the microwave and then stirring. Put in for another 10 seconds and stir again, repeat until melted, being sure to stir well between heating in the microwave.

Pull the cake balls out of the freezer. Using a spoon and toothpick dip the balls into the chocolate one at a time. Once coated in chocolate, gently let the excess drip off. Put the coated balls on a parchment lined pan and add sprinkles before the chocolate hardens. Repeat with the rest of the cake balls using any combination of the chocolate coating.

The chocolate will be set in about an hour. Store for 3-4 days in an airtight container in a cool place.

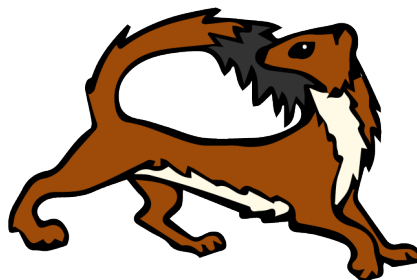

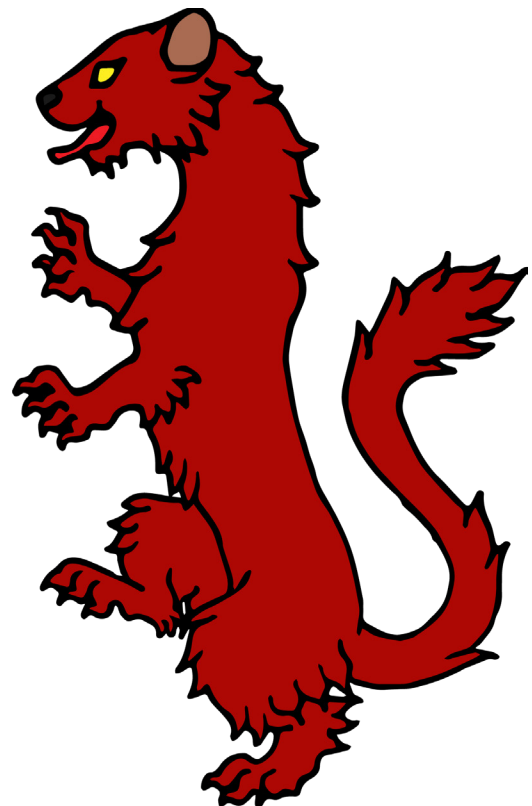

Over 500 Ansteorran already have a People page-- Visit <http://historian.ansteorra.org/wiki/index.php?title=Category:People> to see them.

So much of the SCA is a shared, communal experience, but much of our history is lost, because it is not recorded. There are so many stories to tell - and the Ansteorran Wiki is a beautiful place to share them and preserve them. Wiesenfeuer has a page on the wiki -- but only a tiny smidge of information about its rich history. (<https://historian.ansteorra.org/wiki/index.php?title=Wiesenfeuer>) Won't you share YOUR stories of Wiesenfeuer's history and events - large and small - with the rest of the Kingdom?

You are also invited to become a wiki contributor or editor. Contributing content to the wiki is much, much easier than you think. If you can type an email, you can contribute to the wiki. Content you could share can be as varied as snippets of information about those living or passed who have inspired you (Populace Provided Information), "No (bleep), there I was!" stories, photographs, songs, poems... nearly anything you can imagine!

Having your own page built on the wiki is as easy as filling out an online form (<http://historian.ansteorra.org/submission.php>) and attaching a few photos (though please take a moment to ensure they are less than 1 MG in size first, or they won't attach properly, and rename as YourSCAName - Portrait). Updating an existing page is easy, too! You can either utilize the online form again, filling out only the sections that have been changed (If you use this method: in the SCA Name field, type (Your Name) - Update, and that will let me know it's a page update), or you can use the message form on the main Historian's site: <https://ansteorra.org/historian/>. In the Subject field, type (Your Name) - Update, and then add the information you want updated. I'm also happy to have information sent to me directly via the email address. *I prefer not to receive updates via Facebook Messenger, as it's hard for me to keep track of what I have actioned or not.*

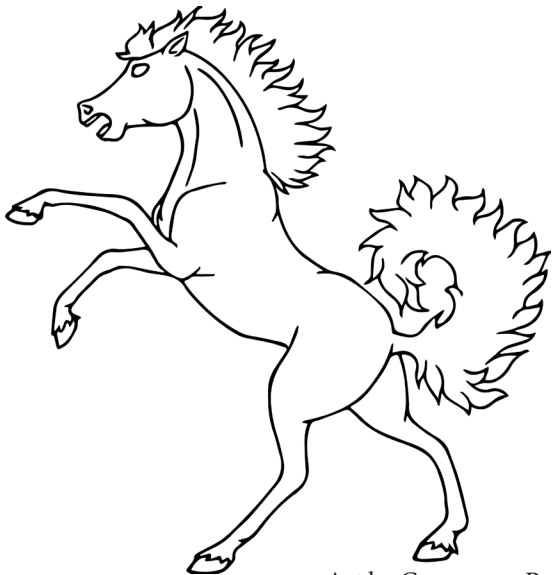
