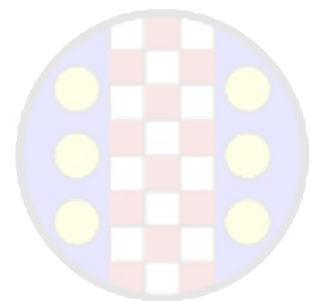

MINISTER OF CHILDREN

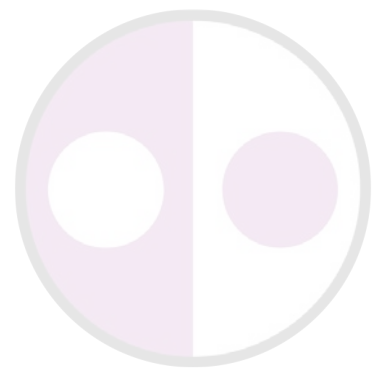
Hello my lovelies!

FIBER GUILD MEETING: WOOL PROCESSING

The fiber guild met this month to start on an ambitious project. We are starting with raw sheep fleece and the goal is to make a final project with it. We haven't decided on a final project yet, but the journey will be fun.

We started off with 3 garbage bags full of fleece and at the last meeting we were able to wash one bag full. We soaked half the bag in just cold water and the other half we added some dish soap to the cold water. This got out a lot of dirt, but the lanolin was still in the fleece. The lanolin is the wool grease and is a waterproofing property that aids sheep in shedding water from their coats.

Usually by the time you get to the finished product the lanolin is washed out, that is done by either scalding the fleece when you wash it in hot water, or it happens in the dyeing process either before or after you spin it into yarn.

We still have a lot to learn and many more sessions. If you are interested in joining us at any time in our journey, look for our meetings posted on the Wiesenfeuer Fiber Guild Facebook group or the Wiesenfeuer Discord Server.

STEPPE'S ARTISAN: SILK REELING

At Steppes Artisan Maestra Masina Da Ferrara demonstrated how to unreel silk. You start off by soaking about 50-100 cocoons in hot water, this loosens the sericin which keeps the threads in a cocoon shape. You then gently gather the end of the silk cocoons with a bristle brush so you can thread the machine to unreel the cocoons. Even with there being 50-100 cocoons the thread is very thin as it winds on the bobbin. It was a very fascinating process to watch as the cocoons bobbed in the water as they unwind like a ball of yarn.

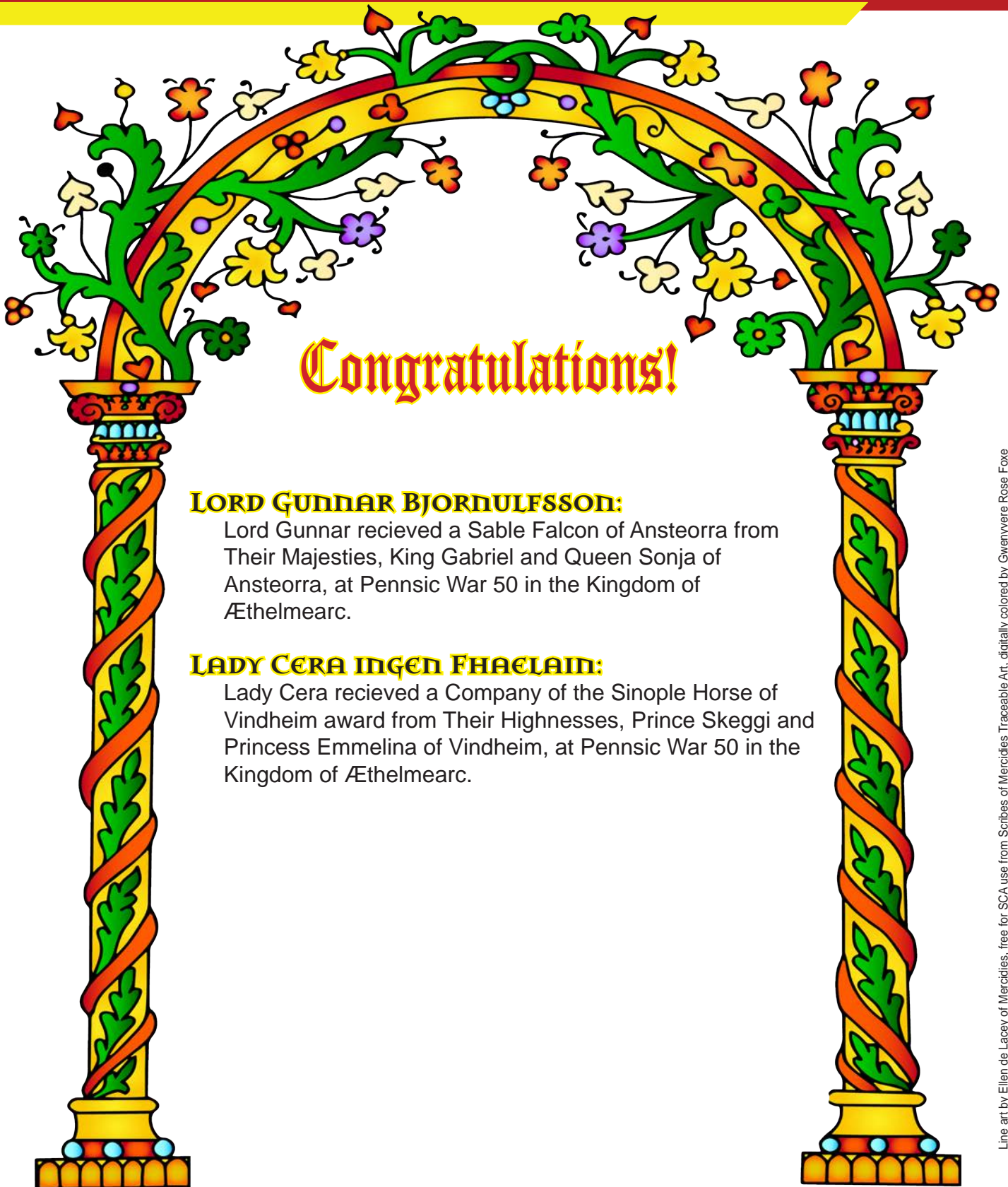

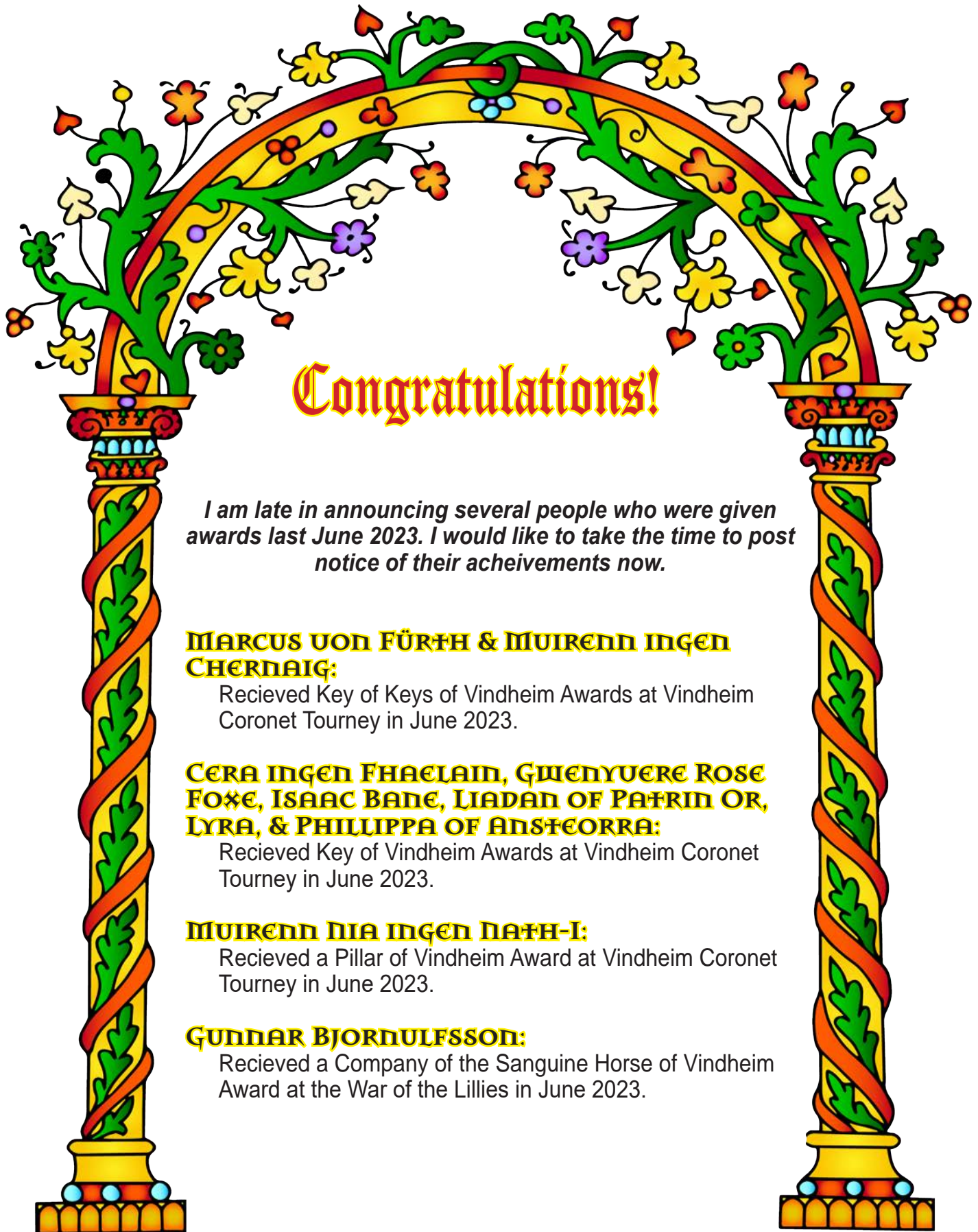

This Month in A&S History

September 2, 1752 - In accordance with a 1750 act of Parliament the British ended their use of the Julian calendar, switching instead to the Gregorian calendar, resulting in a major adjustment as Wednesday, September 2, was followed by Thursday, September 14. The correction resulted in rioting by people who felt cheated

and demanded the missing eleven days back.

The changeover involved a series of steps:

* December 31, 1750 was followed by January 1, 1750 (under the "Old Style" calendar, December was the 10th month and January the 11th)

* March 24, 1750 was followed by March 25, 1751 (March 25 was the first day of the "Old Style" year)

* December 31, 1751 was followed by January 1, 1752 (the switch from March 25 to January 1 as the first day of the year)

* September 2, 1752 was followed by September 14, 1752 (drop of 11 days to conform to the Gregorian calendar)

What are these calendars?

The Julian calendar, which was proposed by Roman consul Julius Caesar in 46 BC, is a solar calendar of 365 days in every year with an additional leap day every fourth year (without exception). The Julian calendar is still used in parts of the Eastern Orthodox Church and in parts of Oriental Orthodoxy as well as by the Berbers, whereas the Gregorian calendar is used in most parts of the world.

The Gregorian calendar, like the Julian calendar, is a solar calendar with 12 months of 28–31 days each. The year in both calendars consists of 365 days, with a leap day being added to February in the leap years. The months and length of months in the Gregorian calendar are the same as for the Julian calendar. The only difference is that the Gregorian reform omitted a leap day in three centennial years every 400 years and left the leap day unchanged.

"What's in a name?" The Chaos of Some Names, Orders, and Titles

So, let's talk about some names and titles!

Some of you have no doubt heard of the order of the Bastion, an order that can only be added to out once her reign by the territorial royalty of the principality of Vindheim. Some of you have likely also heard of the "Bastion herald." This is the administrative herald for Vindheim. And, not surprisingly, there is some confusion about the two names, especially since "bastion" is not a word we use very often.

"Are they the same thing?"

No. The office of Bastion Herald and the members of the Order of the Bastion are separate entities, and don't interact officially at any level. The members of Order of the Bastion were established as a core group of advisers and leaders that could help advise the royalty as the principality grew and matured. The Bastion Herald is the head administrative herald over the principality, and answers directly to the top herald in the kingdom, Star Principal Herald, or "Star" for short.

"So, they don't have anything to do with each other and the names are just coincidence, right?"

Actually, that's not accurate either. but let me explain that a little bit. Historically, officers in the actual colleges of heralds for France, England, Scotland, and other European kingdoms were sometimes named after highly prestigious orders that served the crowns. Having an office that is named after an order or award is one of several different historical

conventions that the current Star Principal Herald included in their decision when changing the name of "Equinox Herald" to "Bastion Herald." The name of the office is an homage to the Order of the Bastion.

"So, what do we call the office?"

Ideally, the proper title is "Bastion Herald," though when you hear heralds talking about various offices, we very (and I mean VERY) often drop the word "herald" from conversation just so we don't have to say that word seven times in a single sentence. Offices are most often abbreviated as things like "Star," "Obelisk," "Golden Staff," "Candelaio", and yes, "Bastion."

"So, how do we tell when you are talking about a member of the Order of the Bastion, or the office of Bastion Herald?"

Actually, that's not necessarily as hard as it sounds. If you are using the word "bastion" as a title, or a proper noun, you are talking about the office of Bastion Herald, because that is the proper name of the office.

But when you're talking about people who have been made a part of the order of the bastion, the award itself actually has no title, and no rank,. As such, there is no prefix or title that you use in front of their name. Where a knight could be called "Sir so-and-so," and a Laurel, or Pelican, or Master of Defense could be called "master" or "mistress" (or one of multiple other corresponding cultural titles), there is no such title or privilege for members of the order of the bastion. You can say someone is 'a bastion,' referring to the fact that they are a member of the order, but you would never call them 'bastion so-and-so,' because the award does not

have a title given to it.

"But, isn't that sort of dumb, since the award is so important?"

There is definitely a conversation to be had about how many and what type of privileges any award has. But in this case, it's important to look back to where the order of the bastion comes from. When Prince Romanus and Princess Deanna created the order, they specifically cited the Ansteorran Lion as its example and inspiration. In fact, Prince Romanus even said "I consider this equivalent to the lion," when he announced the first member of the order. The Lion of Ansteorra is also a non-armigerous award that has no title, and can be given only once per reign, and by only the crown. It is arguably one of the most respected, and for some, the most sought-after awards in the kingdom. But even still, even the oldest lions do not use the award's name as a title. Absolutely no one in Ansteorra should call a them "lion so-and-so".

Regardless of what any of us personally feel about any awards, it is important to understand that the traditions and rules around the order of the Bastion were specifically and deliberately established in the pattern of the Lion of Ansteorra. In this, it is faithful to its source material.

"So, isn't this just a little confusing?"

In a word, **yes**.

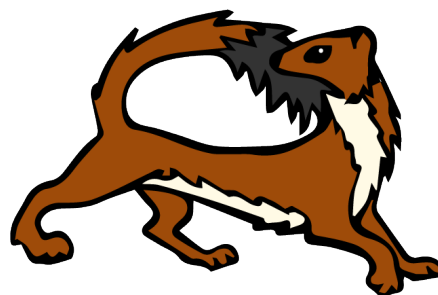
And Bastion isn't the only word that shows up in a few different places. "**Star**" principal herald's office coincidentally shares a name with "**the gold star of Ansteorra**", and "**the order of the Star of Merit**", even though the three have nothing to do with each other at all. We have the local office of the "**knight**

marshal," but we also have "**knights**," and while both involve chivalric fighting, one is an office with a 2 year term, the other is a highly prestigious rank. At the kingdom level, we have the Kingdom '**Earl marshal**,' who is the highest-level officer charged with safety and education in the fighting arts, while at the same time, "**earl**" is one of the more commonly used alternatives to the title "count," which we only give to people after they have stepped down from being crown. And honestly, that's just the short list.

The fact of the matter is that the SCA really isn't any messier or more confusing that real life is, or ever was. Part of the human condition (then, and now) is the at-times messy, wild, and often fun, chaos of names and titles that we both have in the SCA, and read about in cultures from centuries ago. The real answer to any of these does not start with changing things to make them simpler.

Rather, we start by putting a concerted effort into learning more about them, their history, and their reasons for being, and then asking ourselves if the name really needs to be changed, or if we just need to make sure we constantly ask more and deeper question so that we are always striving to improve our understanding.

Have you ever wondered, "Who, or what, is that?" and then browsed the internet to look up a person, place, event, thing, or concept on Wikipedia? Wikipedia isn't solely a website, it's also a collaborative software that any group can use to create its own knowledgebase. Ansteorra has its very own Wiki with over 1,200 pages! The Ansteorra Wiki is the publicly accessible records of the Kingdom Historian's office, documenting the people, places, events, and traditions of our Kingdom. This can be a great way to learn about households, individuals, guilds, awards, specific Reigns - you name it. You can browse via categories of information, or search for a specific page. Anyone who lives or has lived and participated in Ansteorra is eligible to have a People of Ansteorra page. On it, you can chronicle your SCA experience to the extent and depth that you are comfortable doing. We can track your service and participation, host photos of A&S projects, and notate your wishes in circumstances where you might be called into court. Over 500 Ansteorran already have a People page-- Visit <http://historian.ansteorra.org/wiki/index.php?title=Category:People> to see them.

So much of the SCA is a shared, communal experience, but much of our history is lost, because it is not recorded. There are so many stories to tell - and the Ansteorran Wiki is a beautiful place to share them and preserve them. Wiesenfeuer has a page on the wiki -- but only a tiny smidge of information about its rich history. (<https://historian.ansteorra.org/wiki/index.php?title=Wiesenfeuer>) Won't you share YOUR stories of Wiesenfeuer's history and events - large and small - with the rest of the Kingdom?

You are also invited to become a wiki contributor or editor. Contributing content to the wiki is much, much easier than you think. If you can type an email, you can contribute to the wiki. Content you could share can be as varied as snippets of information about those living or passed who have inspired you (Populace Provided Information), "No (bleep), there I was!" stories, photographs, songs, poems... nearly anything you can imagine!

Having your own page built on the wiki is as easy as filling out an online form (<http://historian.ansteorra.org/submission.php>) and attaching a few photos (though please take a moment to ensure they are less than 1 MG in size first, or they won't attach properly, and rename as YourSCAName - Portrait). Updating an existing page is easy, too! In the Subject field, type (Your Name) - Update, and then add the information you want updated. I'm also happy to have information sent to me directly via the email address. *I prefer not to receive updates via Facebook Messenger, as it's hard for me to keep track of what I have actioned or not.*

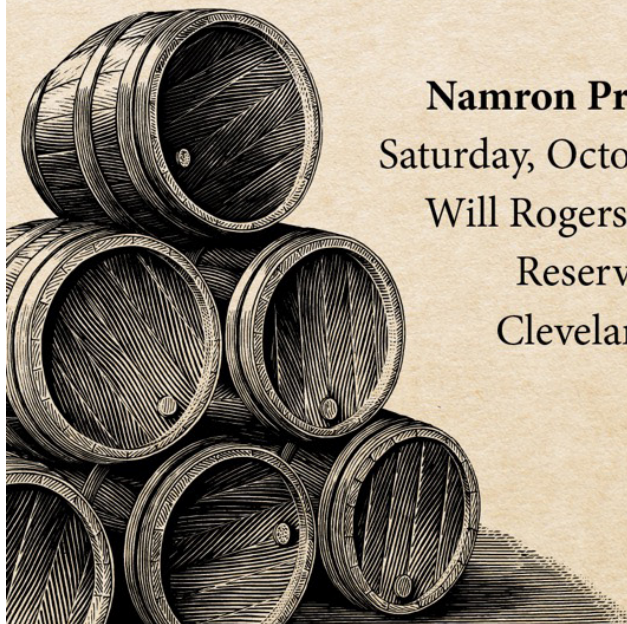
