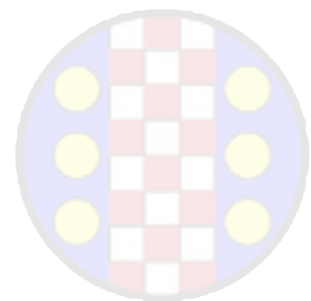

MINISTER OF CHILDREN

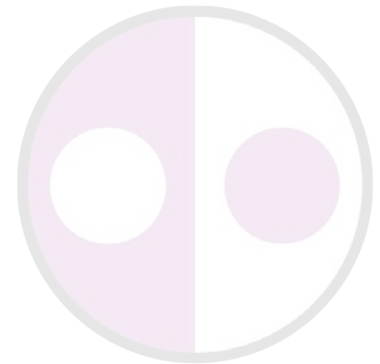
Hello my lovelies!

Isabeau's Historia

How a Domestic Sin Gave Birth to Holey Innovation: The Mystery Behind Leavened Bread

Long before we had baker's yeast made up of fast acting domesticated strains that are conveniently dried and need only be combined with water or chemical leaveners like baking soda or baking powder, there was sourdough. The National Institutes of Health defines a starter as "a spontaneous sourdough ecosystem that consists of a mixture of flour and water that is fermented by endogenous lactic acid bacteria (LAB) and yeasts" (Boreczek). There are thousands of strains of yeast that can be obtained from either a sourdough culture or beer barm, which is the foam formed on the top of fermenting liquid. Both records from antiquity and scientific evidence support that humans utilized sourdough cultures first to leaven bread. In fact, there is evidence that the Sumerians and other Mesopotamians used this form of leavening and quite possibly they passed that knowledge to the Egyptians, but nevertheless the first historical reference to sourdough leavening comes from Egypt circa 1500 B.C.

For the Egyptians, bread was a staple with grain

even used as a form of currency. We have desiccated loaves taken from tombs and sites like Amarna that show breads in forms such as triangular, spiral, and even shaped like animals (Rubel 29). These breads were carefully formed or molded and left for deceased loved ones in tombs or as offerings to the gods. Archeologists have identified at least 40 distinct types of bread by the New Kingdom, many of these leavened (Mehdawy 25). One of these leavened breads was a cone-shaped bread sometimes weighing multiple kilos called *T-hedge*.

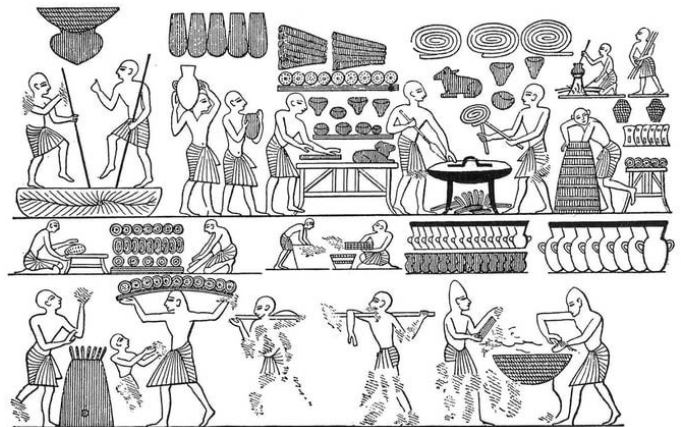


Figure 2: Depiction of an Egyptian bakery from the tomb of Ramses III - note the different bread shapes, especially the cow. Definitely a new bread baking goal!

In Egypt's early period, barley was the dominant crop but emmer wheat, one of the earliest cultivated wheat varieties, was known even during the Old Kingdom and by the New Kingdom had all but replaced barley for bread making (Scott MF). One important reason for this is that only wheat has the gluten structure required to form the web-like matrix capable of trapping the carbon dioxide produced during yeast/bacteria fermentation. So we know Egyptians had the wheat they needed and a sourdough culture requires only that, moderate temperatures, and water – oh and of course the yeast!

There's a reason they refer to sourdough as "spontaneous fermentation" and that is mainly due to the way yeast populates the grain and water mixture. Not that it appears out of nowhere like a magical fungus fairy but that it is already in the environment all around us, especially in areas that contain the food sources it loves like fruits, grains, and beer – all of which the Egyptians had in abundance. And what could yeast love more than a warm bowl of cereal porridge – all the things it needs: a food source,

water, and a nice, warm environment. A little like living in a food hot tub. The only other thing needed is for the yeast to have time to produce the byproduct carbon dioxide which creates all those telltale bubbles and for the lactic acid bacteria to lower the PH of the mixture which prevents bad bacteria from spoiling the culture.

So maybe that porridge was neglected for a day or two, possibly even longer depending on the environment but the guilty party no doubt took notice, or a glaring spouse, when they looked closer and saw those strange bubbles and next the sour but not altogether unpleasant smell. It could have been curiosity or frugality that prompted whoever found it to stick it in an oven or on a griddle but once they did no doubt their eyes widened as all those trapped gases expanded and caught in the gluten web producing a light delicacy of baked dough with a taste unlike anything they had ever experienced before. After that, as people do, they must have shared it with others and conjectured about what had happened, and just as people today they put what happened together and over time began perfecting the art of leavening first by means of sourdough and later also using beer barm.

Of course there are other theories. Maybe the art of brewing also taught them something about leavening or maybe it was a piece of dough rather than porridge that was left out too long and became uncharacteristically puffy. We may never know the details but according to archeologist Magda Meh-dawy, we know Egyptians knew of and passed down the sourdough method – a holey innovation that may very well have its origins in one of the most infamous domestic sins.

Wiesenfeuer's history and events - large and small - with the rest of the Kingdom?

You are also invited to become a wiki contributor or editor. Contributing content to the wiki is much, much easier than you think. If you can type an email, you can contribute to the wiki. Content you could share can be as varied as snippets of information about those living or passed who have inspired you (Populace Provided Information), "No (bleep), there I was!" stories, photographs, songs, poems... nearly anything you can imagine!

Having your own page built on the wiki is as easy as filling out an online form (<http://historian.ansteorra.org/submission.php>) and attaching a few photos (*though please take a moment to ensure they are less than 1 MG in size first, or they won't attach properly, and rename as YourSCAName - Portrait*). Updating an existing page is easy, too! You can either utilize the online form again, filling out only the sections that have been changed (If you use this method: in the SCA Name field, type (Your Name) - Update, and that will let me know it's a page update), or you can use the message form on the main Historian's site: <https://ansteorra.org/historian/>. In the Subject field, type (Your Name) - Update, and then add the information you want updated. I'm also happy to have information sent to me directly via the email address.

I prefer not to receive updates via Facebook Messenger, as it's hard for me to keep track of what I have actioned or not.
