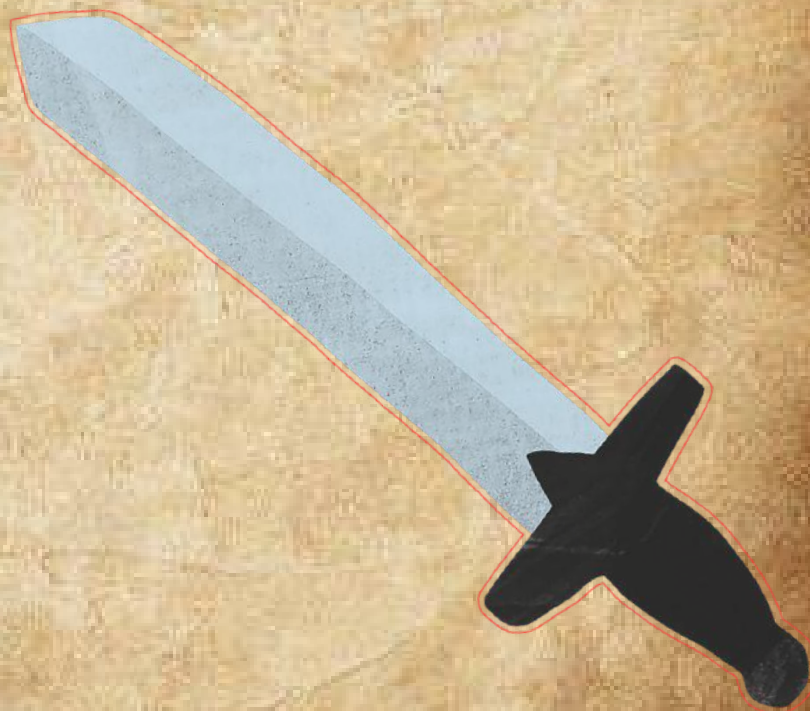

Ansteorra Story

I was a witness to not only Ansteorran history, but also Known World history in the fall of 1990. Some of you may not know that Ansteorra was the first kingdom to ever have a Queen by Right of Arms and I was there.

It was the Fall of 1990. We had gathered in Emerald Keep for Crown Tournament. I remember it was a pleasant day. The fighting went well from what I recall. It came down to the last round. It was the best 2 out of 3 between Duke Hector and Duchess Rowan: husband and wife. We were all gathered around the list field in anxious anticipation. The bout began and Rowan took it. The crowd grew quieter for the second bout. Hector took this one.

It was the third bout. Who would take it? The fight began. I'm sorry I am unable to give details of the fight. All I recall is that EVERYONE was standing around the field in utter silence. You could have heard a pin drop in the dirt. Then, gasp, they both fell. "Who won?" Someone shouted from the side of the field. When the marshal said "Rowan" the crowd went wild. Cheering and clapping and yelling. The knights and fighters rushed onto the field, picked Rowan up on their shoulders and started to parade her around the field as she yelled "Put me down! Put me down! Put me down!" They eventually did.

It was an awesome day for Ansteorra and the Known World to have the first Queen by Right of Arms.

I heard people mumbling at later events that Hector "let her have it." But I know from good authorities that if he had "let her have it, she would have killed him".
