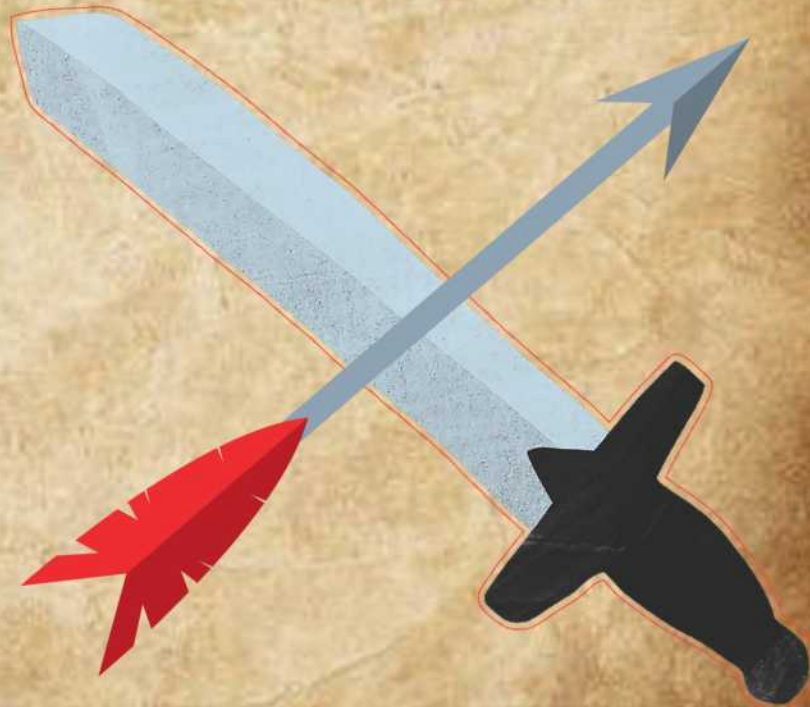

Stew

Since the cold is coming in I thought I'd share my favorite stew recipe to use at home or at camp!

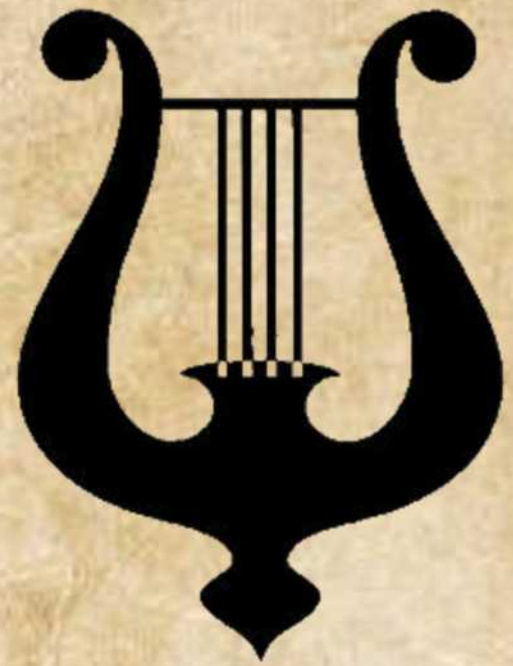
