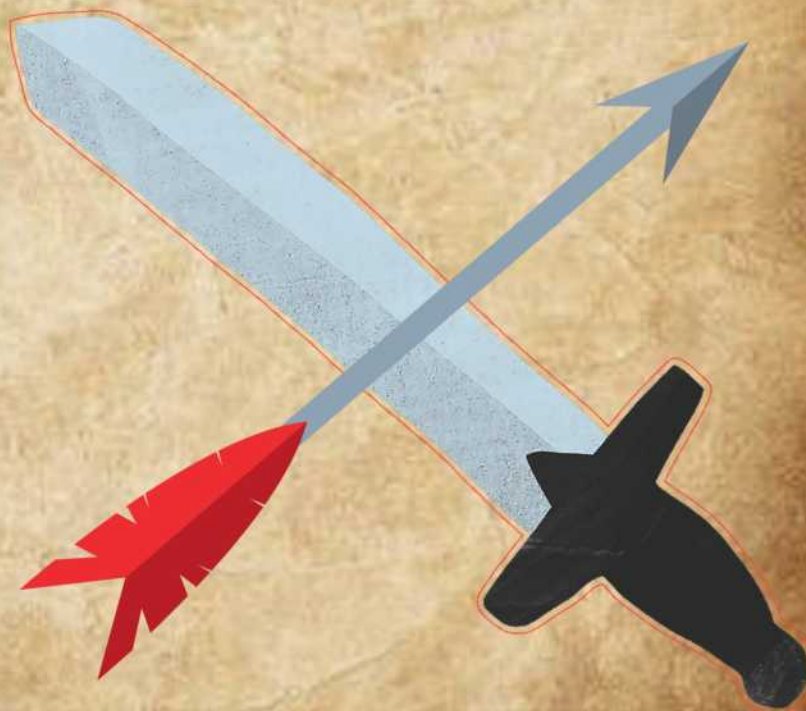

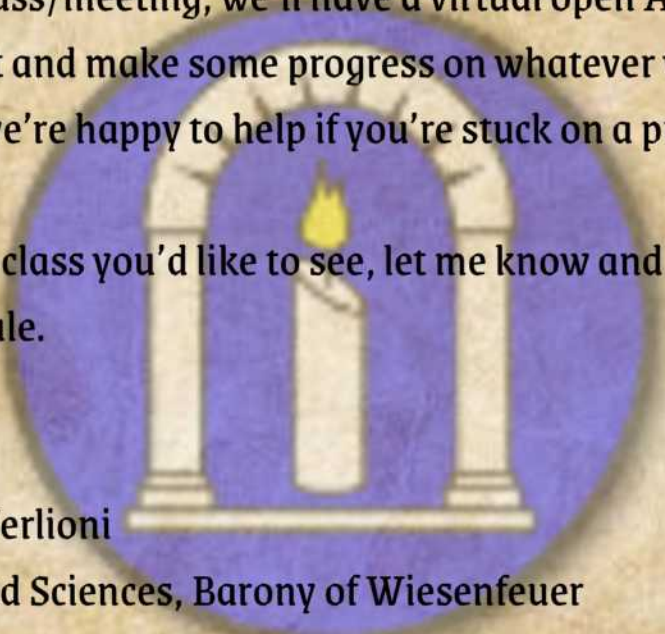

Jambalaya

Vaduny cel Tradat

2 Tbsp peanut oil, divided

1 Tbsp Cajun seasoning

1 onion, diced

1 small green bell pepper, diced

2 stalks celery, diced

3 cloves garlic, minced

1 (16 ounce) can crushed Italian tomatoes

½ tsp red pepper flakes

½ tsp ground black pepper

1 tsp salt

2 tsp Worcestershire sauce

1 ¼ cups uncooked white rice

2 1/2 cups chicken broth

10 ounces andouille sausage, sliced into rounds (I use kielbasa if I can't find the andouille)

1 lb boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1 inch pieces

- 1. Heat 1 Tbsp of peanut oil in a large pot with a lid over medium heat.*
- 2. Season the sausage and chicken pieces with Cajun seasoning.*
- 3. Sauté sausage until browned.*
- 4. Remove with a slotted spoon, and set aside.*
- 5. Add 1 Tbsp peanut oil, and sauté chicken pieces until lightly browned on all sides.*
- 6. Remove with a slotted spoon, and set aside.*
- 7. In the same pot, sauté onion, bell pepper, celery, and garlic until tender.*
- 8. Stir in crushed tomatoes, and season with red pepper, black pepper, salt, hot pepper sauce, & Worcestershire sauce*
- 9. Stir in chicken and sausage.*
- 10. Cook for 10 minutes, stirring occasionally.*
- 11. Stir in the rice and chicken broth.*
- 12. Bring to a boil, reduce heat, and simmer for 20 to 25 minutes, or until liquid is absorbed.*
- 13. Serve and enjoy*

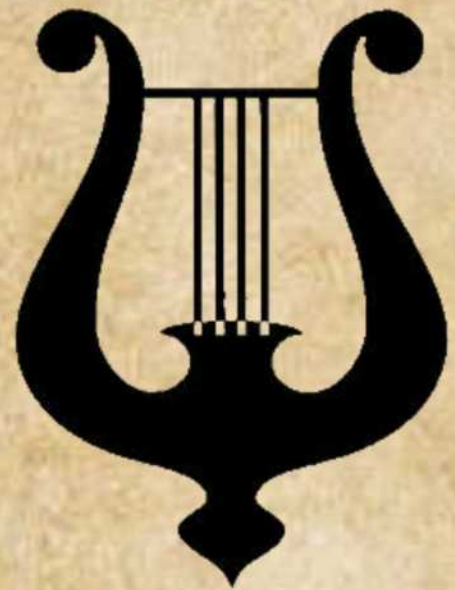
