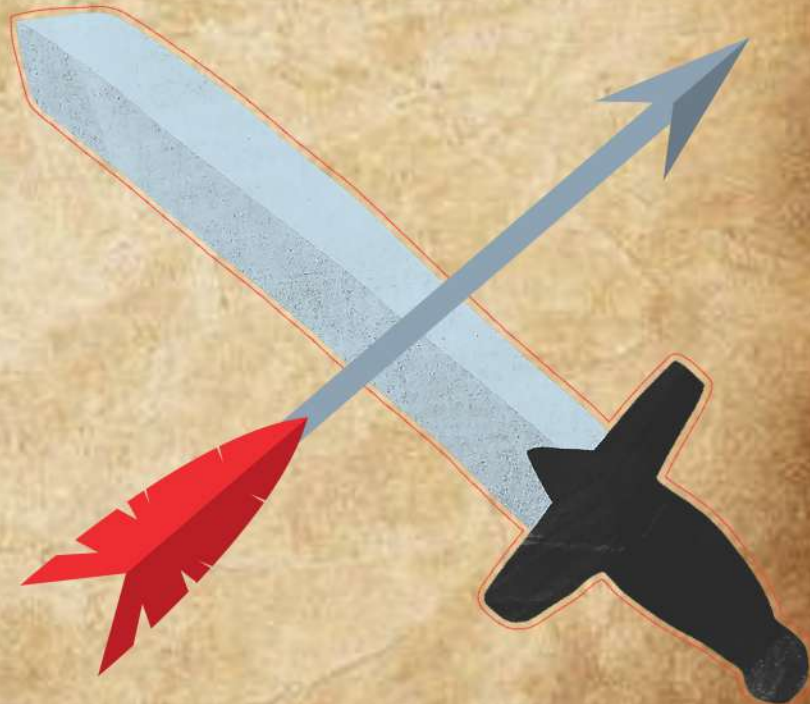

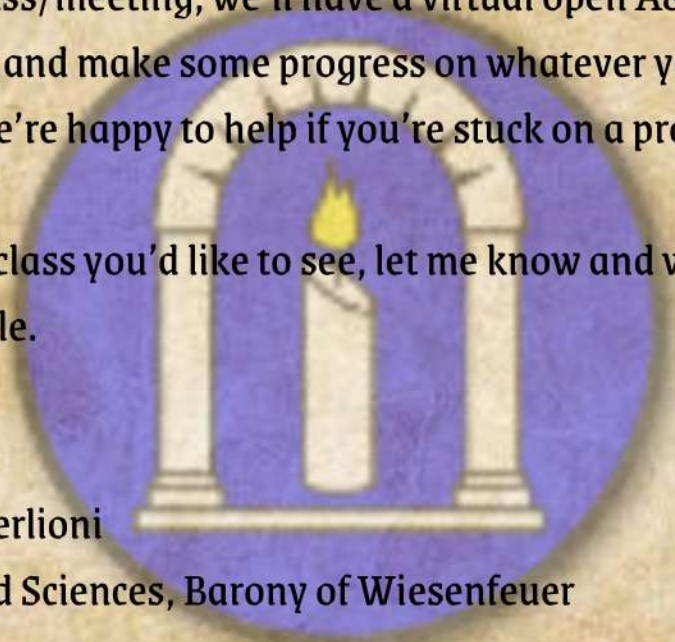

Haduny's Meringue Cookies

Prep: 20 Minutes

Bake: 90 Minutes

Oven: 200° F

3 Egg Whites

1/4 tsp Cream of Tartar

1/4 tsp of Extract (Mint, Lemon, Root Beer, etc)

1/8 tsp Salt

3/4 cup Sugar

Food Coloring (optional)

Food Coloring Paste (optional)

Piping Bag and 1/2 inch Open Star Tip

Preheat oven to 200° F. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper and set aside.

In a large mixing bowl combine egg whites, cream of tartar, extract and salt. (and food coloring)

Beat with a mixer on medium speed until soft peaks form. (tips curl)

Gradually add sugar, about 1 tablespoon at a time, beating on high until stiff peaks form (tips stand straight)

With a clean small paintbrush paint stripes of food coloring paste on the inside of a piping bag fitted with 1/2 inch open star tip. Carefully transfer meringue into bag. Pipe 2 inch stars about 1 inch apart onto cookie sheet.

Bake for 90 minutes or until meringues appear dry and are firm when lightly touched. Transfer cookies to a wire rack to cool
