# 8 Curious Facts About Life in the Middle Ages

Vaduny cel Tradat

1. Eels were sometimes used as currency-- A record survives showing someone once rented land in the fenlands for 26,275 eels.

2. Archery practice was for a time compulsory for every able Englishman-- England became a breeding ground for the best archers in the world. Edward III introduced a law which made archery practice compulsory every Sunday to ensure the king always had a steady supply of archers available. The subsequent English victories at Crecy, Poitiers and Agincourt proved the law provided dividends.

3. Football was banned in England on multiple occasions--On 13 April 1314 for instance, King Edward II issued a proclamation that banned football in London. The reason?

"...there is great noise in the city caused by hustling over large balls from which many evils may arise which God forbid; we command and forbid, on behalf of the King, on pain of imprisonment, such game to be used in the city in the future."

4. Merchants were a class of their own-- Not only did many travel far and wide to obtain exotic goods, but merchants also had the opportunity to get very rich from imports and exports.

5. The man who carried the King's hunting birds to the hunt carried them on a wooden frame called a 'Codge'.-- These men were usually elderly and trustworthy servants, and were called 'Codgers'. This is where we get the term, 'Old Codgers'.

6. A medieval Lady, if she was very wealthy, might own as many as six metal needles.-- In the 14th century, metal needles were more expensive than diamonds.

7. After a great battle, it was often the job of the local women to help count the bodies of the men killed (lucky ladies). As dead bodies are so heavy, it was much easier to simply chop off the hand of the corpse and place it in a large canvas bag, which was later emptied for counting. The bag was commonly called a 'handbag', leading to the name we have for women's bags today. (Although, you probably wouldn't dance around one in a nightclub.)

8. During the Middle Ages, tattoos had several functions.-- Some of them were used as a form of punishment for criminals. Others were gotten by Christian pilgrims to show off their devotion and to commemorate their journey to holy sites. Some professions or people from certain social statuses also got tattoos. For example, knights would get tattooed to show their allegiance to a particular lord or kingdom, while sailors would commemorate their experiences at sea.
