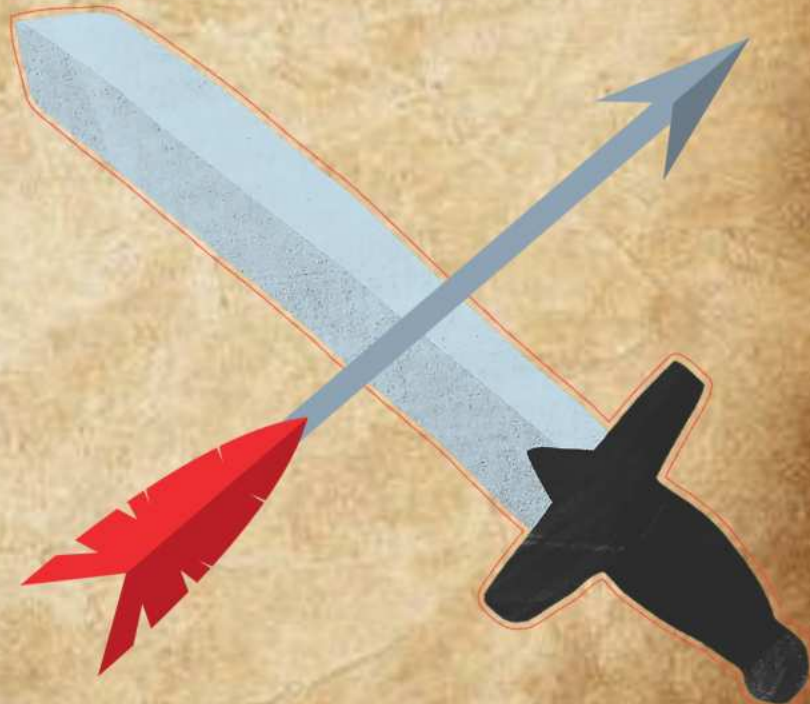

Requirements:

4. The design should expressly tell people they are welcome to engage with the SCA. ("You are welcome", or "please come in" for example).

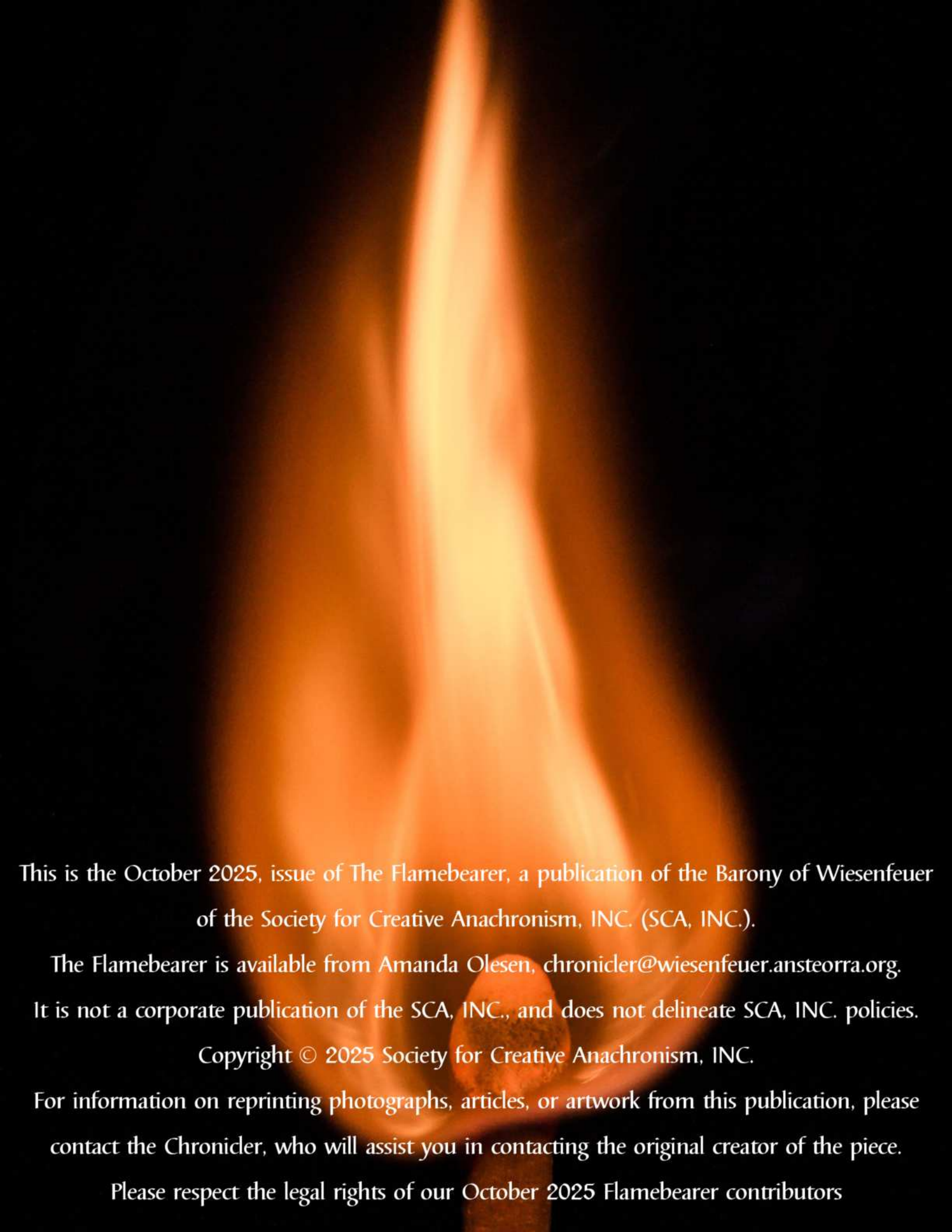
